






San Giovanni Teatino





San Giovanni Teatino is a comune and town in the Province of Chieti in the Abruzzo region of Italy.

Situated on a hill overlooking the valley of the river Pescara, in recent years the place has undergone an industrial development, especially in the area of Sambuceto (San Giovanni Teatino). In fact, the municipality is virtually divided into two, San Giovanni Teatino (Alto), which is the historic village on the hill, and the aforementioned Sambuceto, an ever-growing urban settlement, home to a large shopping area and an important industrialized area.

Baixa da Banheira







Baixa da Banheira is a Portuguese village located in the district of Setúbal, in the Lisbon region and sub-region of the Península de Setúbal, with a population of about 21 085 inhabitants with a last count in 2011.

It was an extinct (aggregated) parish, in 2013, within the scope of a national administrative reform, having been added to the parish of Vale da Amoreira, to form a new parish called Union of Freguesias of Baixa da Banheira and Vale da Amoreira.


Kraziai



Czestochowa



Bucharest


