After the conquest of the city by Jaime I in 1265, the mosque remained standing until 1334 and, on it, a first Catholic temple was built, probably in the Gothic style and with a cross plan, which would survive until 1492.

One dish that is a must at every important family event – Christmas, Easter, weddings, you name it – is Sarmale, arguably considered Romania's national dish. Sarmale can be described as stuffed cabbage rolls. A balanced mixture of minced meat (usually pork and beef, but veal is also used) and rice, with pieces of traditional bacon, chopped onions

and herbs (dill, parsley, thyme) is rolled in sour white cabbage leaves (sauerkraut) and very slowly cooked in clay pots in the oven, covered with cabbage brine, tomato sauce and pieces of smoked meat or traditional bacon and fresh thyme sprigs or pepper.

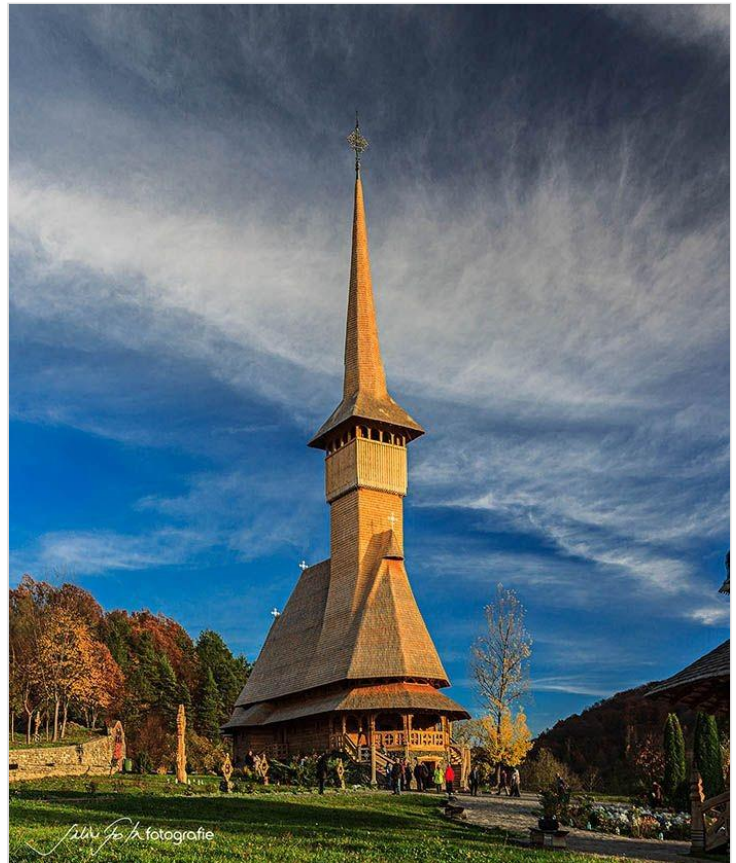

Located in the northern part of Romania, in a place described as “probably one of the most peaceful, picturesque, full of tranquility and positive energy places from Romania”, the wooden churches of Maramures are architectural masterpieces which reflect the best example and variety of wood carving design and craftsmanship. They also reflect the role that religion has played in the local community, as well as centuries old traditions that are still being carried out today. Out of about 100 old wooden churches in Maramures, 8 were included in UNESCO heritage as a sign of recognition of their cultural significance and uniqueness.

Pastéis de Belém - Filme História

No início do Século XIX, em Belém, junto ao Mosteiro dos Jerónimos, laborava uma refinação de cana-de-açúcar associada a um pequeno local de comércio variado. Como consequência da revolução Liberal ocorrida em 1820, são em 1834 encerrados todos os conventos e mosteiros de Portugal, expulsando o clero e os trabalhadores. Numa tentativa de sobrevivência, alguém do Mosteiro põe à venda nessa loja uns doces pastéis, rapidamente designados por "Pastéis de Belém". Na época, a zona de Belém era distante da cidade de Lisboa e o percurso era assegurado por barcos de vapor. No entanto, a imponência do Mosteiro dos Jerónimos e da Torre de Belém, atraía os visitantes que depressa se habituaram a saborear os deliciosos pastéis originários do Mosteiro. Em 1837, inicia-se o fabrico dos "Pastéis de Belém", em instalações anexas à refinação, segundo a antiga "receita secreta", oriunda do mosteiro. Transmitida e exclusivamente conhecida pelos mestres pasteleiros que os fabricam artesanalmente, na "Oficina do Segredo". Esta receita mantém-se igual até aos dias de hoje. De facto, a única verdadeira fábrica dos "Pastéis de Belém" consegue, através de uma criteriosa escolha de ingredientes, proporcionar hoje o paladar da antiga doçaria portuguesa.

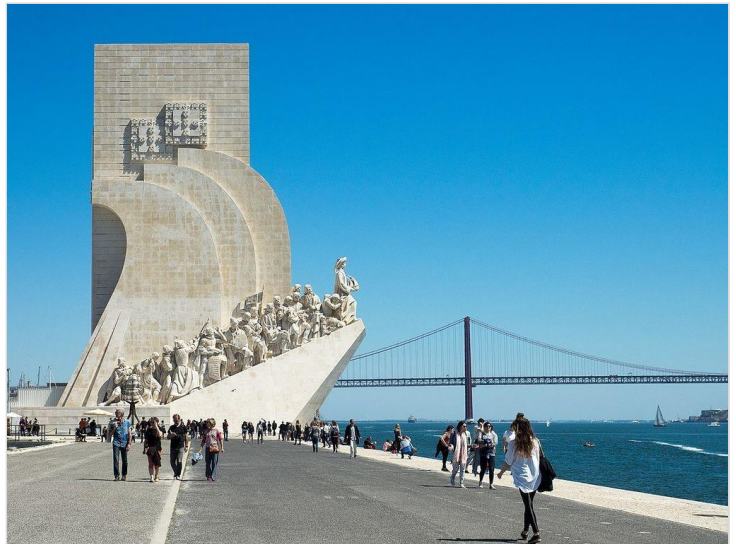

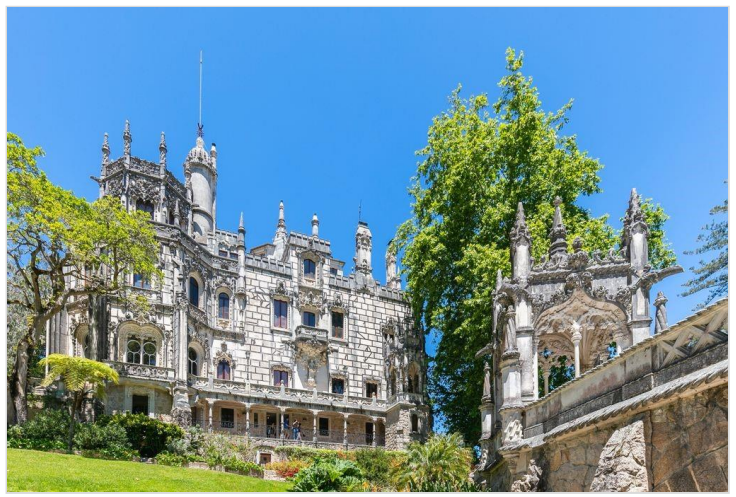
