Blue / White / Red.**

These colors symbolizes the French Revolution (1789) - the blue and the red represent the colors of Paris and the white represents the origins, that is, royalty.



The Muguet, tradition of the French spring

The "Muguet" is a flower that appears in the fields of France in the spring. The tradition is to harvest this flower with the family on May 1 and offer it as an amulet that brings happiness to those who receive it.



EIFFEL Tower

The Eiffel Tower is a 19th century iron tower located on the Champ de Mars in Paris, which has become a worldwide icon.

The tower, which is the tallest building in the city, is the most visited paid monument in the world and was built as the entrance arch of the Universal exhibition of 1889.

His name was in honor of the Tower designer, engineer Gustave Eiffel.



Legend: The 666 glass of the LOUVRE pyramid

A legend narrated in the book of journalist Dominique Stezepfandt – "François Mitterrand, great architect of the universe", says that the pyramid of the Louvre would have been devoted to the devil, containing exactly 666 glasses, arranged according to a game Arithmetic between addition, multiplication and triangular representations of the number 6.

The exact number is still unknown, and the information is declared official – 673 – somewhat mysterious.

The legend still says that the body of former president François Mitterrand – who commissioned the work of the pyramid at the time – would be buried underneath it, being reinforced by Dan Brown's book – "The Da Vinci Code".
