Objectives:

Students will:

- 2. Recognize symptoms that suggest that the patient needs first Aid

- 4. Use digital devices
- 5. Practice and develop the communication skills required for their future proffesion

1. Lead in

> Teacher introduces the topic First Aid with a Nearpod lesson.

2. Guided practice

- > Nearpod is a student engagement platform designed for use in class.
- With Nearpod, teachers interact with students and view student responses in real time, enabling students to take ownership of their learning rather than passively viewing a teacherdirected whole-class presentation.
 - 1. The teacher needs to create an account in Nearpod. This is free of charge or maybe your school have the school edition.
 - 2. Upload a Powerpoint
 - 3. Start adding activities; quiz's, polls, videos, drawing- boards, web content, matching pairs, memory test, 3D
 - 4. You can change the order of your slides

Type of material: Lesson plan

- 5. Share the wanted Nearpod with the class by pressing Live session/ Studentpaced, give the student the code to access (iPad, smartphone, computer). Students dont have to create an account.
- 6. After session you get a report on students results

3. Problem solving – Puppet Pals2
