31 is a very popular card game, there are many variations of this game, of which I will talk about one of them.

The goal is not to exceed 31 points









The cards which has each player count as many points as he has, ie the one that writes 5 is 5 points, the card with number 2 is the same. All figures count for 10 points. When the player has an ace, ie 1, the player calculates it as he wants, either as 1 point or as 11 points, but when the player has two aces, then one must count for 11 points.





How it is played

31 is played by two or more players, up to those in the team.

A player undertakes to shuffle the deck well, and then leave it on the table.

The player to his right draws a card, then all the players do the same. Any player can stop whenever he wants by saying the word "pass", while whoever thinks he needs more cards he takes them in turn. In the end, after the last pass is said, all the players announce the number they have reached, that is, those who win must count their cards in front of everyone.









Who wins

The player who scores 31 points wins, whichever player exceeds 31 points burns and loses, in case no one has completed 31 points, the one who has the most points from the others wins, ie 30 or 29 or 28 and goes on to say, in case. The draw is won by the players who have drawn, ie if two players win, it is considered that each has made a victory.
