- ❖ Place and date of birth: he was born on September 8 , 1947, in Porto.
- Profession: doctor, teacher and researcher in the field of Biochemistry.
- Current prominent position: Director of IPATIMUP (The Institute of Molecular Pathology and Immunology of the University of Porto).

- PhD in Pathology, Faculty of Medicine, University of Porto, in the study of thyroid cancer.
- * He did a Post-Doctorate in Oslo, at the "Norsk Hydro's Institute for Cancer Research", subordinated to the theme "Electron Microscopy".
- ❖ In Oslo he established connections, which allowed him to be recognized internationally.
- Through the "Norsk Hydro's Institute for Cancer Research" he has an important role in the field of Thyroid Pathology, inaugurating a relationship with the international scientific research environment.

In 1989, he founded the IPATIMUP (The Institute of Molecular Pathology and Immunology of the University of Porto).

- constitutes one of the three European labs accredited by the American College of Pathologists.





This unit annually carries out hundreds of diagnostic consultations for hospitals and oncology institutes in Europe and America.

- Appointed Full Professor of the 4th Group (Pathology);
- As head of the European Society of Pathology, he organized the first two intercontinental congresses of Pathology with the Latin American Society of Pathology (2000 and 2004);
- ❖In 2000, he formed the Moscow (Russia) division of the European School of Pathology;
- He directed the XVIII European Congress of Pathology, in Berlin, in September 2001, and developed the division of Ankara (Turkey);



- ❖ He is a member of the Scientific Councils of the European School of Pathology, the European Course in Cellular Pathology and the European Association for Cancer Prevention;
- Member of the Editorial Committee of the Association of Directors of Surgical Pathology of the United States (ADASP);

- In 2015, he was elected the most influential pathologist in the world by the British magazine The Patologist;
- He won several awards, such as the Rotary Club of Porto, from the engineer António de Almeida Foundation, Teacher Doctor, Luís de Pina and Boehringer Ingelheim.
