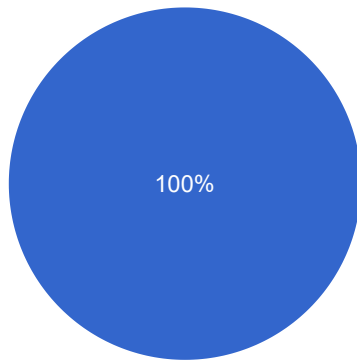

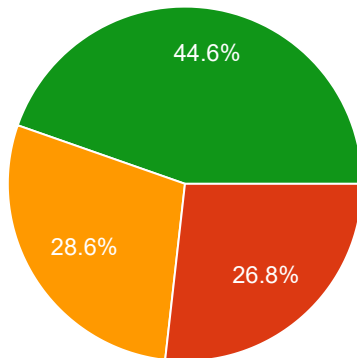

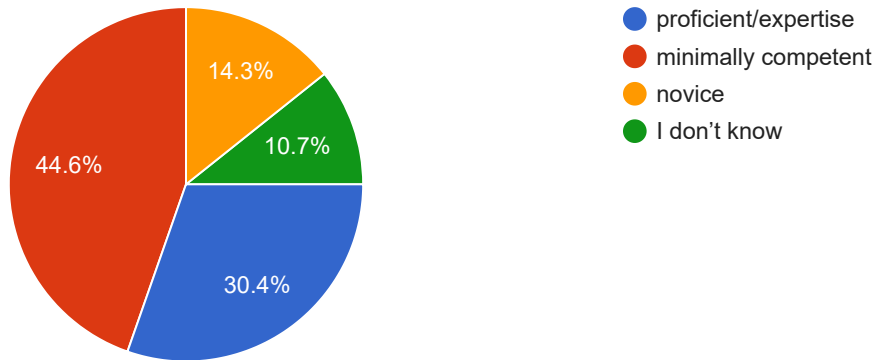

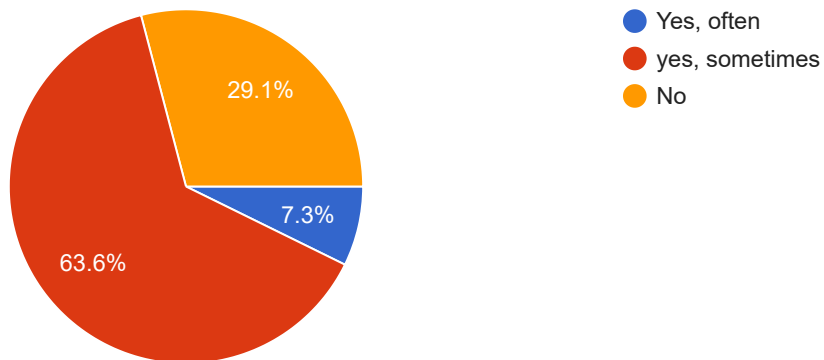
How do you consider your level of expertise when using the internet?

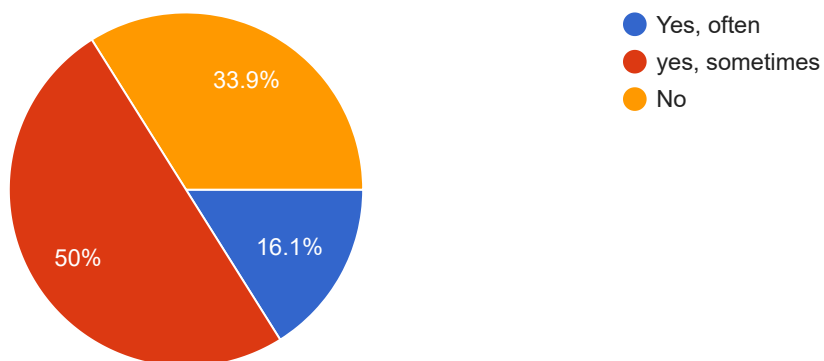

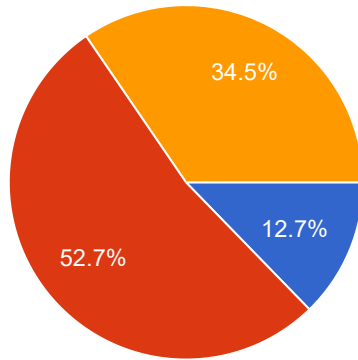

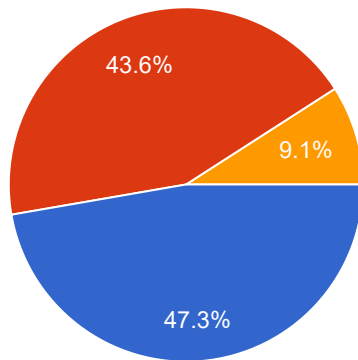

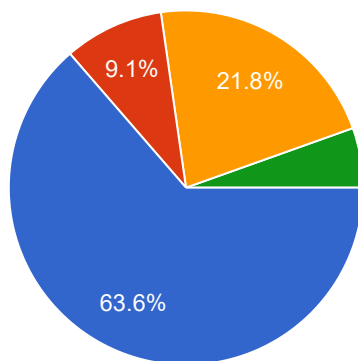

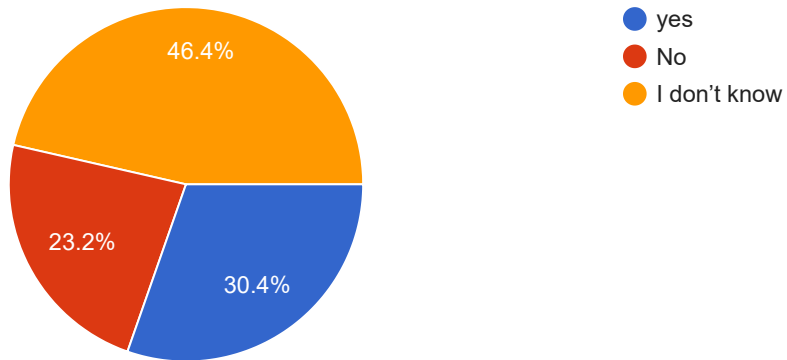

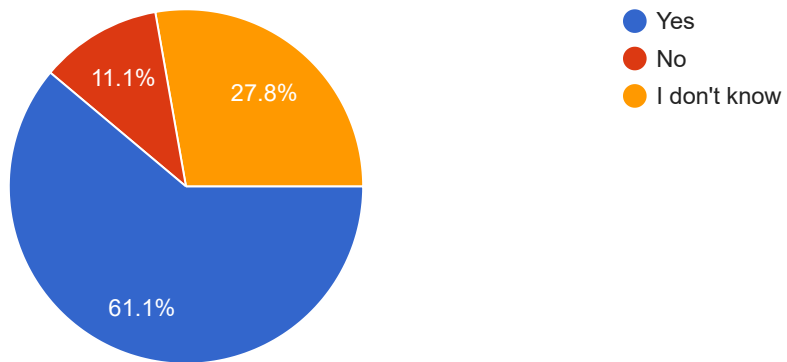

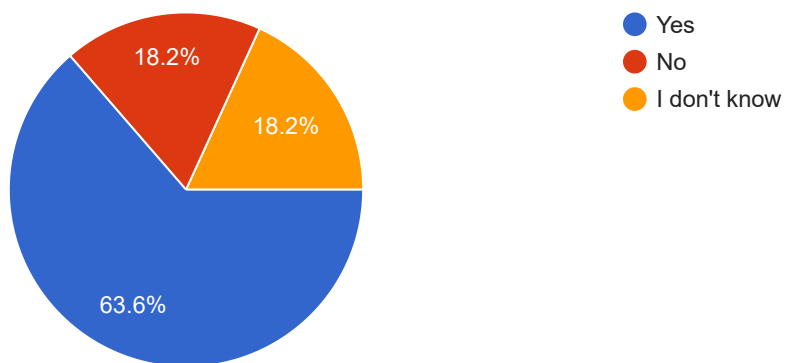

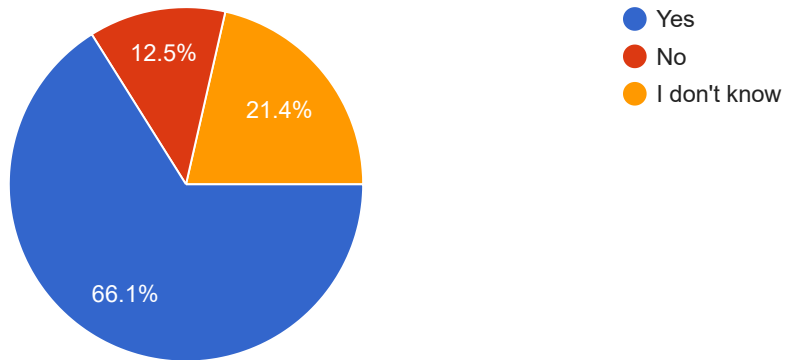

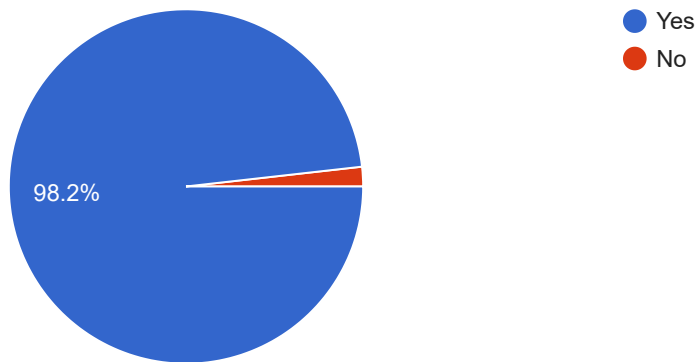

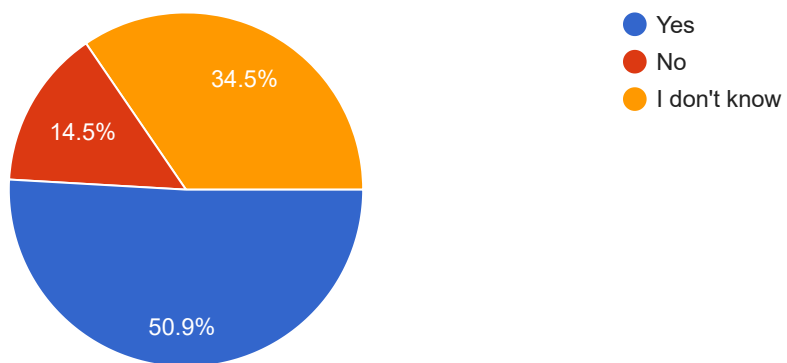

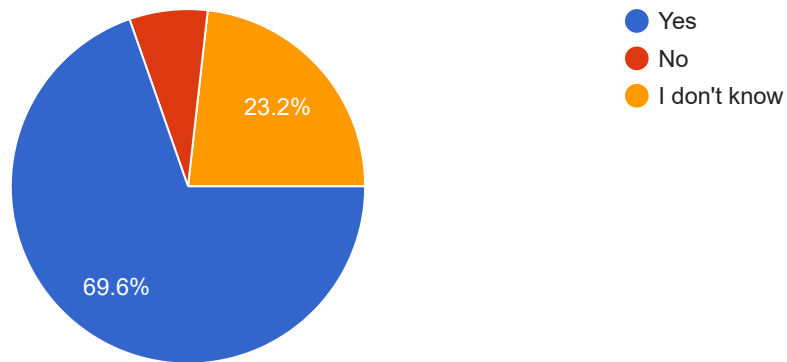

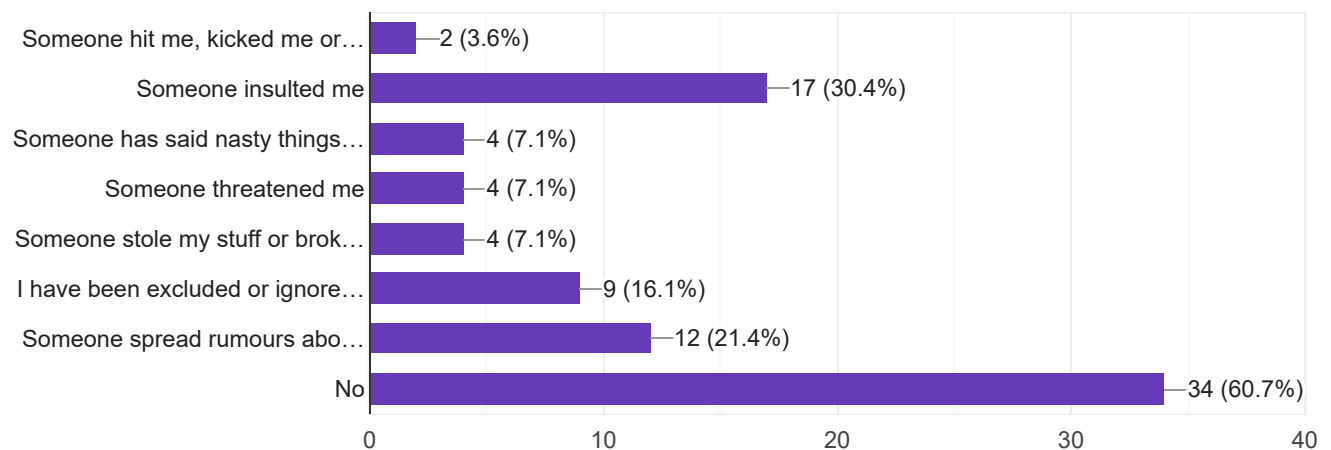

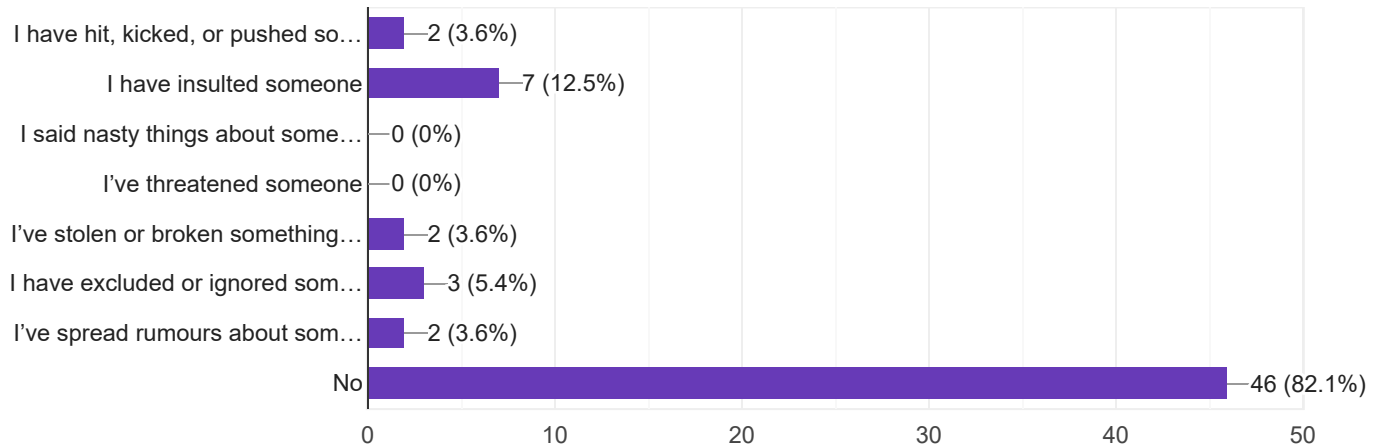
Have you ever been bullied?

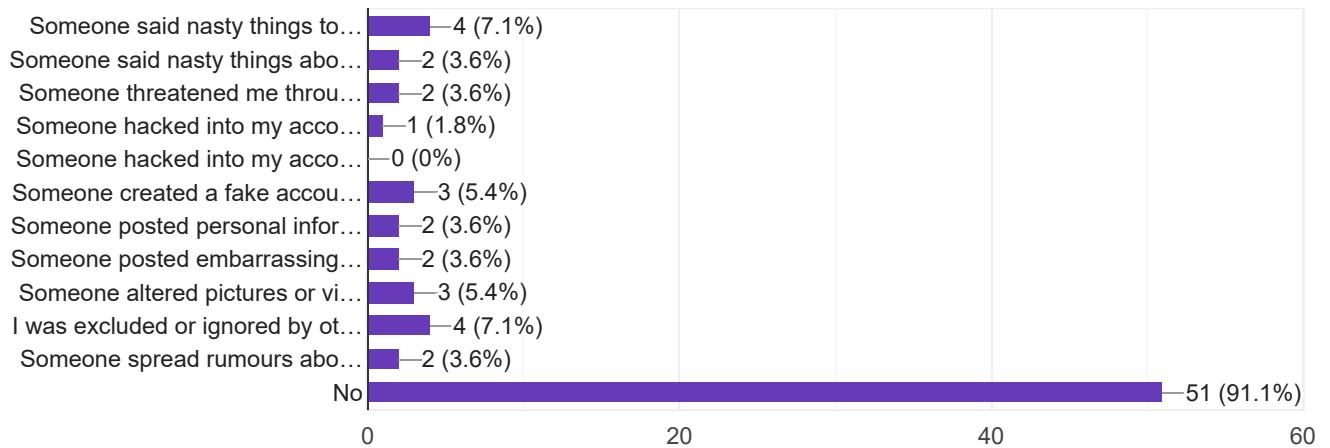
