## Think about how to protect yourself online!

Someone is bullying you on social media. Do you know who has sent the messages?





Can you **talk to them** and tell them how you feel?





Do you know how to **report content** to the site owner?





Ask them to remove the content.

Explain to them why it is making you unhappy.
Does this stop the bullying?





Good! Report the content

 give as much information as you can including URLs and if possible, screenshots.



Consid

Consider **blocking them** so you don't have to look at the content. **Report them** to the site owner – ask a responsbile adult for help. Does this stop the bullying?




