**ARTIGO 22º**  All people are entitled to all the advantages (culture, work, social protection).

We all have the right to work, to have enough wages to live and support the family. If a man and a woman do the same work, they should have the same salary. **ARTIGO 23º** 

**ARTIGO 24º**  All people have the right to rest from work and have paid vacations.

Everyone has the right to a good and socially secure life. **ARTIGO 25º** 

**ARTIGO 26º**  All people have the right to education which should be Free.

Everyone has the right to create. All have the author's rights on the materials created by themselves. **ARTIGO 27º** 

**ARTIGO 28º**  In order that your rights must be respected, there must be an order that can protect them.

Every man has duties to society. The defined rights and freedom may never be against what is defined in the United Nations. **ARTIGO 29º** 

**ARTIGO 30º**  Any society, any human being in any part of the world can destroy the described rights.

## HOW DID HUMAN RIGHTS ARISE?

After a long period of indefinite rights, the Declaration of Human and Citizens Rights was actually announced on August 26, 1789, in France. It is closely related to the French Revolution. This Universal Declaration of Human Rights with the common goal to be achieved by all peoples and nations, aims to promote respect for rights and freedom, and the adoption of progressive national and international measures.

**ARTIGO 1º** All people are free and equal and should help each other.

**ARTIGO 2º** All people must be respected, even of another race, of another colour, of another sex, of another language, of another religion.

**ARTIGO 3º** Everyone has the right to life, liberty and personal security.

**RESPECT**

**ARTIGO 4º** All people have the right not to be abused.

**ARTIGO 5º** No one shall be subjected to torture or to cruel, inhuman or degrading treatment or punishment.

**ARTIGO 6º** All people should know their rights.

**ARTIGO 7º** All people are equal by the law.

**ARTIGO 8º** All people have the right to be defended by a lawyer if they disrespect the law.

**ARTIGO 9º** No one can be arbitrarily arrested, detained or exiled.

**ARTIGO 10º** All people have the right to defend a cause that is fair and to be judged by a court.

**ARTIGO 11º** All people are innocent until they are proved as guilty. No one shall be condemned for actions that at the moment of practicing them were not a crime.

**ARTIGO 12º** We all have a right to our privacy. No one should get involved in your life, your family, your home or your correspondence.

**ARTIGO 13º** Everyone has the right to move freely in his or her country. Everyone has the right to leave the country in which he/she is, including his own, and the right to return to his country.

**ARTIGO 14º** All people who are being persecuted have the right to seek protection in other countries. This right can not be used in the case of people committing a common law crime that it is against United Nations.

**ARTIGO 15º** Everyone has the right to belong to a nation and no one can stop you from changing his / her nationality.

**ARTIGO 16º** Man and woman have the right of getting married and build a family.

**ARTIGO 17º** You have the right to own things and no one has the right to take them from you without a reason.

**ARTIGO 18º** You have the right to freely choose your religion, to change and to practice alone or with others.

**ARTIGO 19º** All men have the right of freedom of opinion.
