

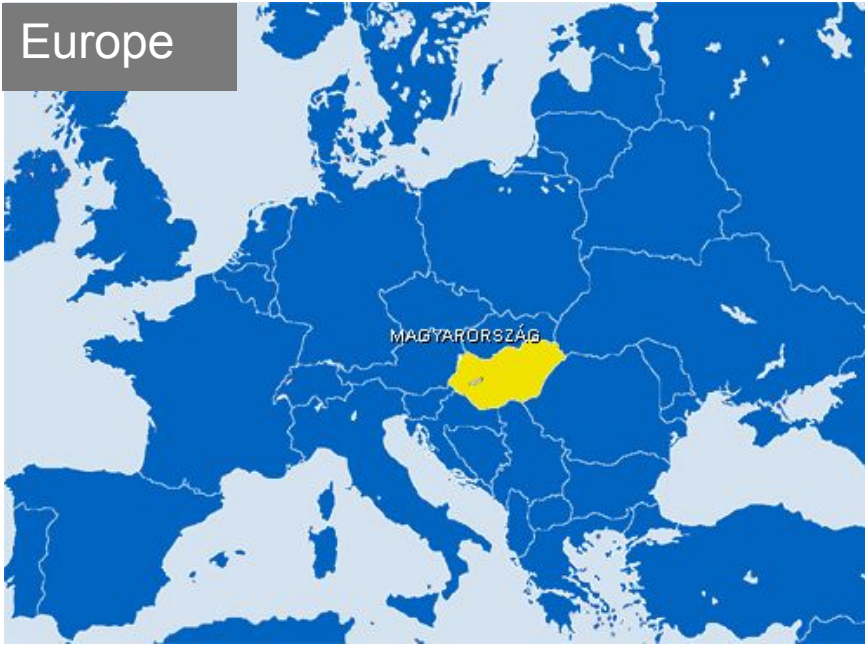

Dunamenti Power Station. Its flues are 207 metres tall.

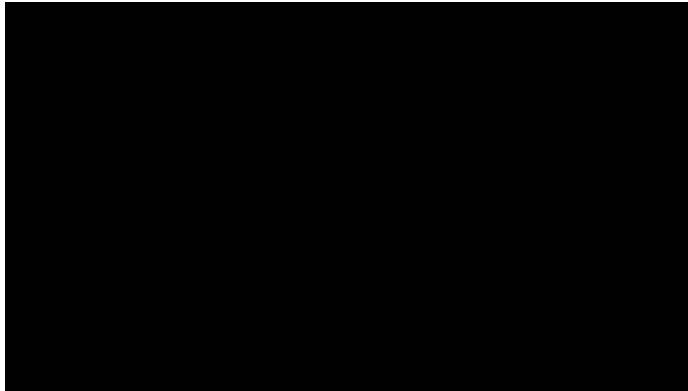
St. Stephen Square. This is the main square and our school is situated opposite the conference centre.

Our school is located in the centre of Százhalombatta, in the main square.

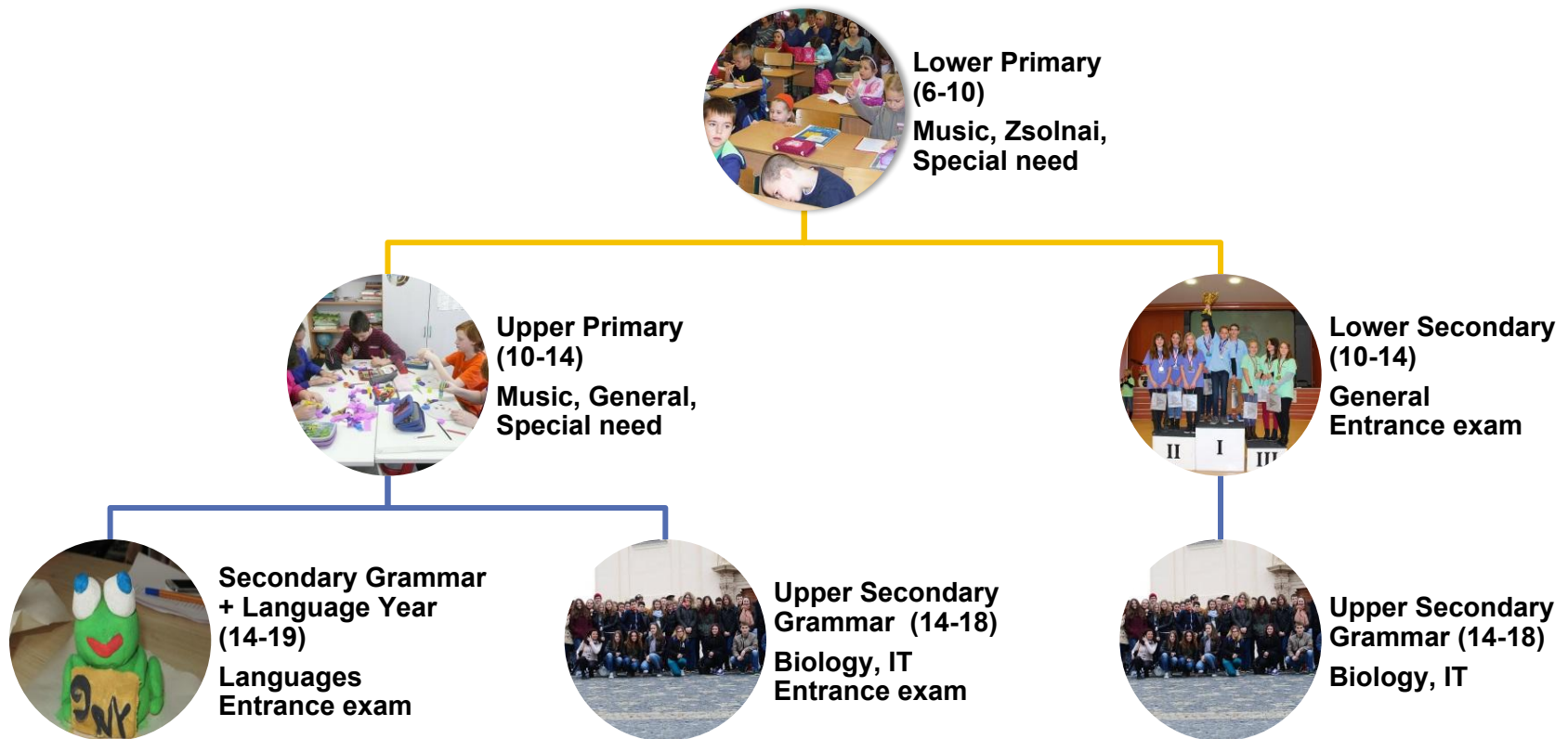
The current headmaster is dr. Horváthné dr. Hidegh Anikó.

LANGUAGE YEAR
