A: All in Spanish, with a class about Basque language.


B: equal proportion between the two languages.

D: All in Basque, with a class about Spanish languae.

G: All in Spanish.

## Description of the Spanish Educational System



## PRE-SCHOOL

- 1st cycle: 0-3 years. Voluntary and private.

- 2nd cycle: 3-5 years. Voluntary and free. Attendance 98%.



## PRIMARY SCHOOL

#### Three cycles of two years:

- 1st: 6-8 years

- 2nd: 8-10 years

- 3rd: 10-12 years



## SECONDARY SCHOOL

#### **COMPULSORY**

#### Two cycles of two years:

- 1st: 12-14 years.
- 2nd: 14-16 years.



## KEY COMPETENCES

- Mother tongue and foreign languages.
- Mathematical competence.
- Competence in Science and Technology.
- Digital competence.
- Learning to learn.
- Social and civic competences.
- Sense of iniciative and entrepeneurship.
- Cultural awareness and expression.



## HIGH SCHOOL

#### **NON-COMPULSORY**

Three different educational paths, as preparation for college or for high vocational

training:

- Sciences.
- Humanities.
- Art.



## VOCATIONAL TRAINING

Two cycles, at the end of each students get a degree.

- MIDDLE
- HIGH

After finishing a High Vocational Training, students can enroll in a university.



### UNIVERSITIES

- In order to study at university, students join an examination called UNIVERSITY ENTRANCE EXAM.
- Once having the mark of this examination, students choose the degree they want to study and the university
- > Degrees of 4 years (except for medicine, architecture and pharmacy)
  - Students can choose a post-graduate (masters) study after their degree graduation
  - After a post-graduation, a doctorate is possible
