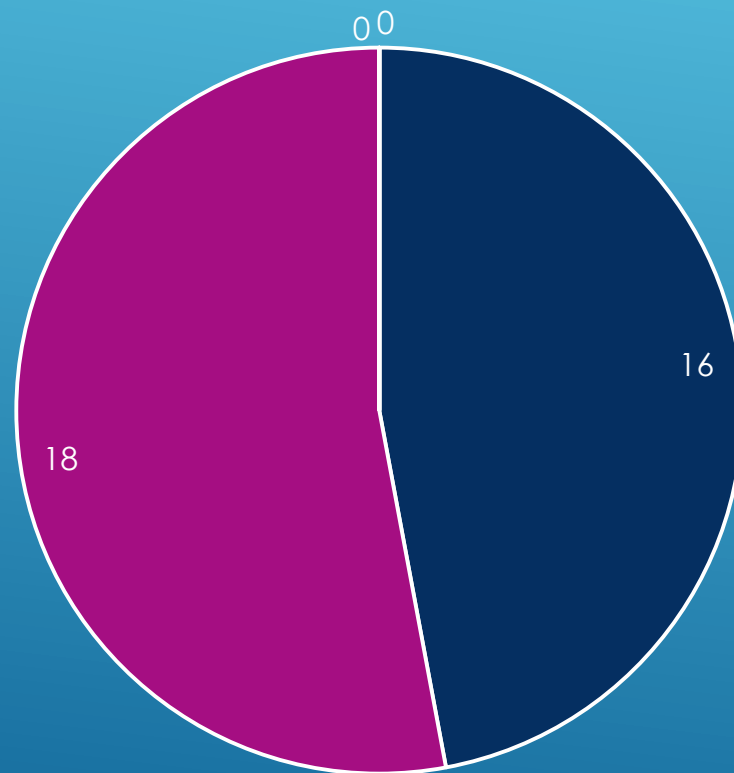

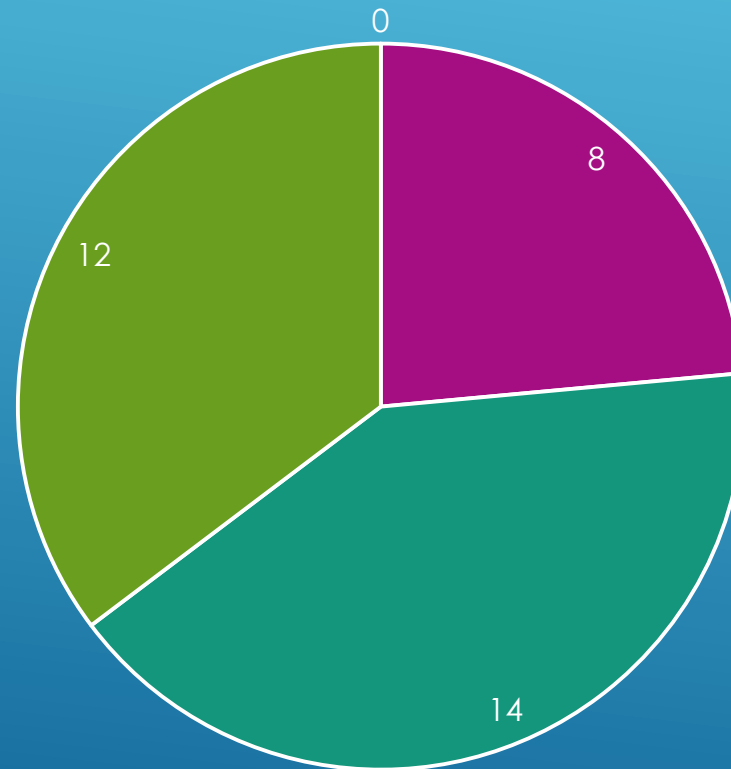

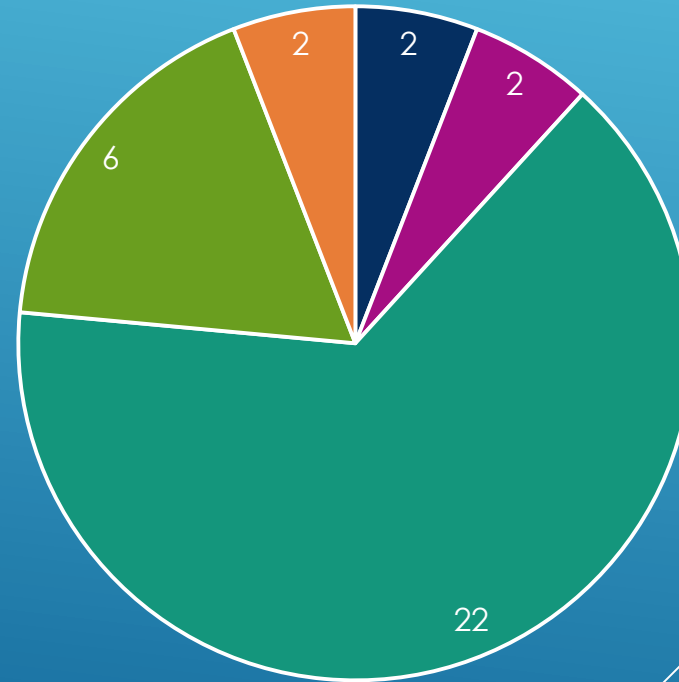

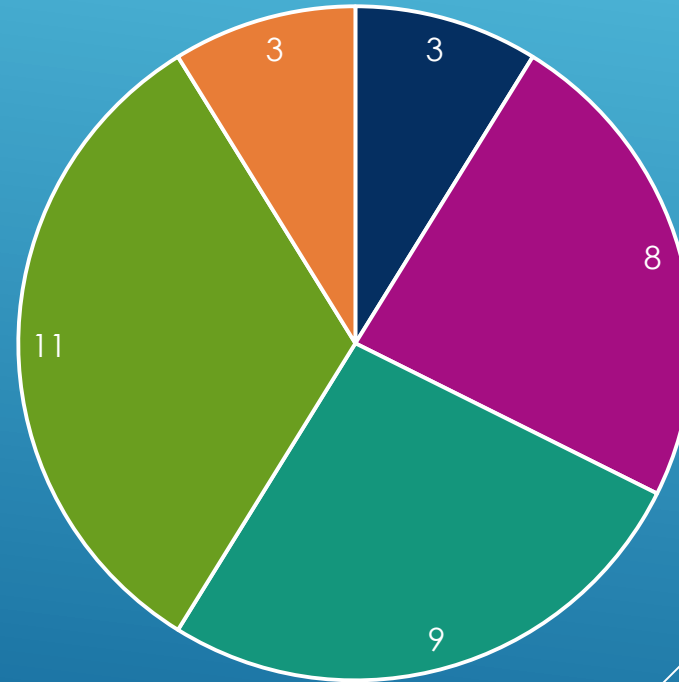

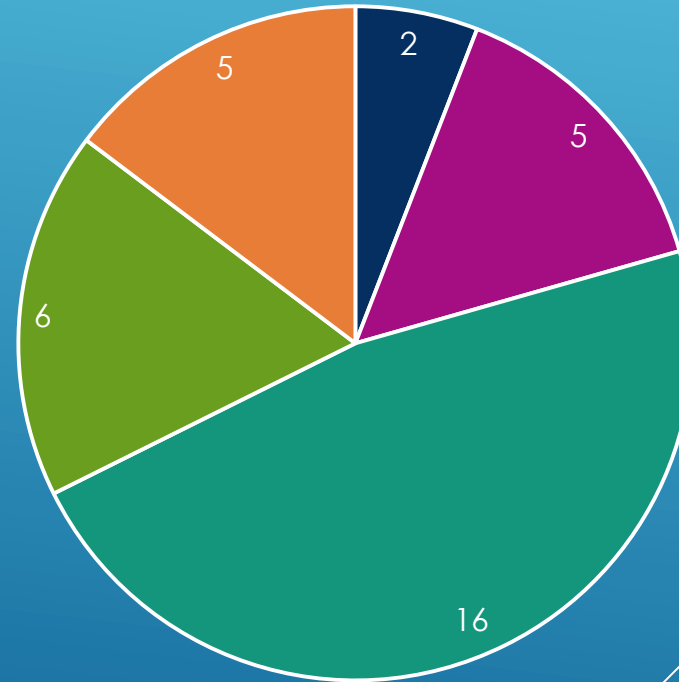

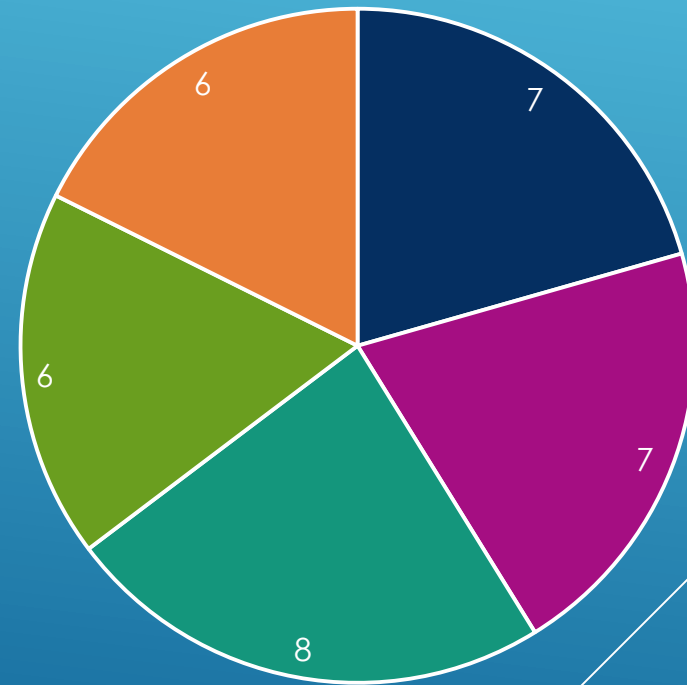

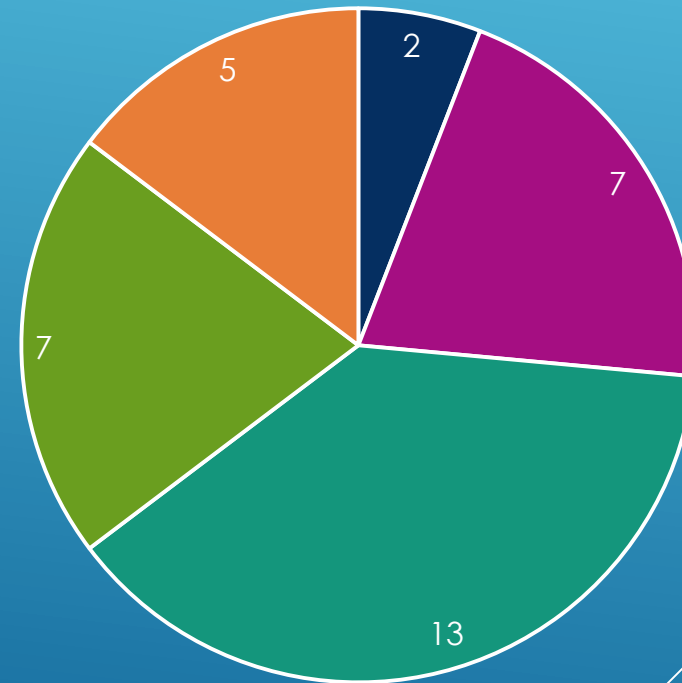

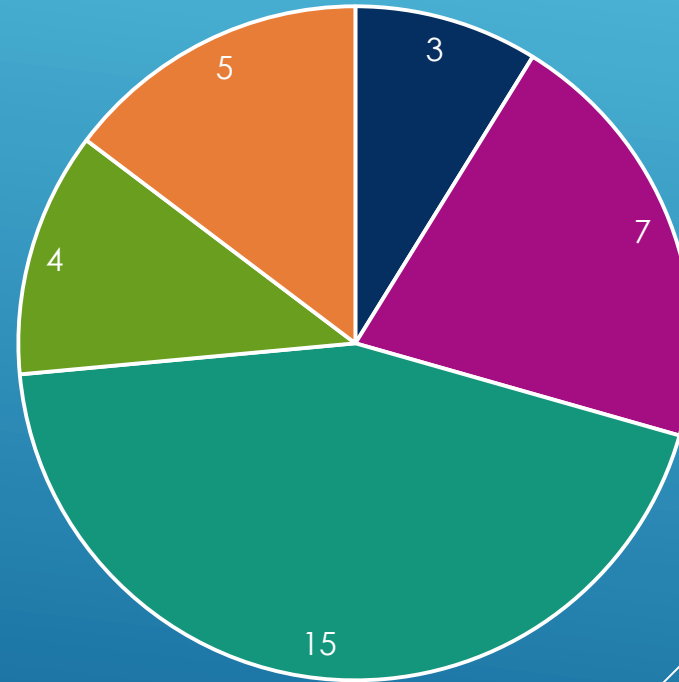

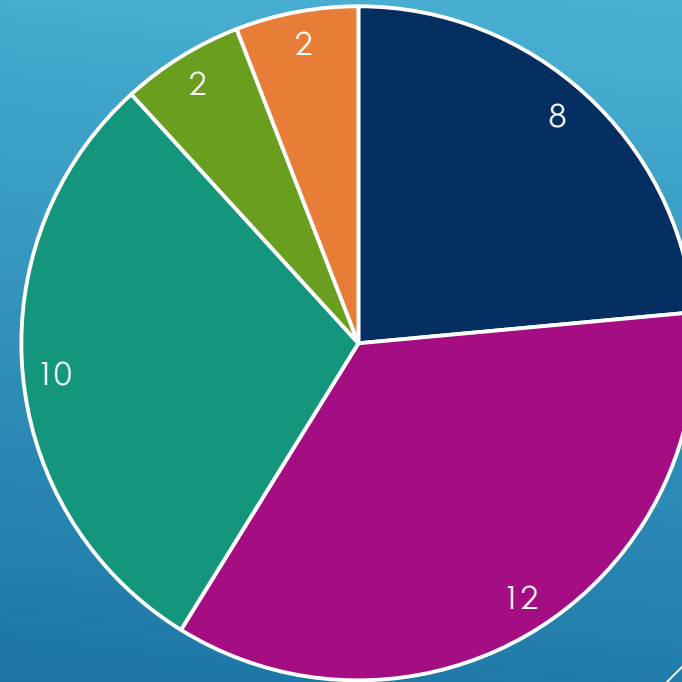

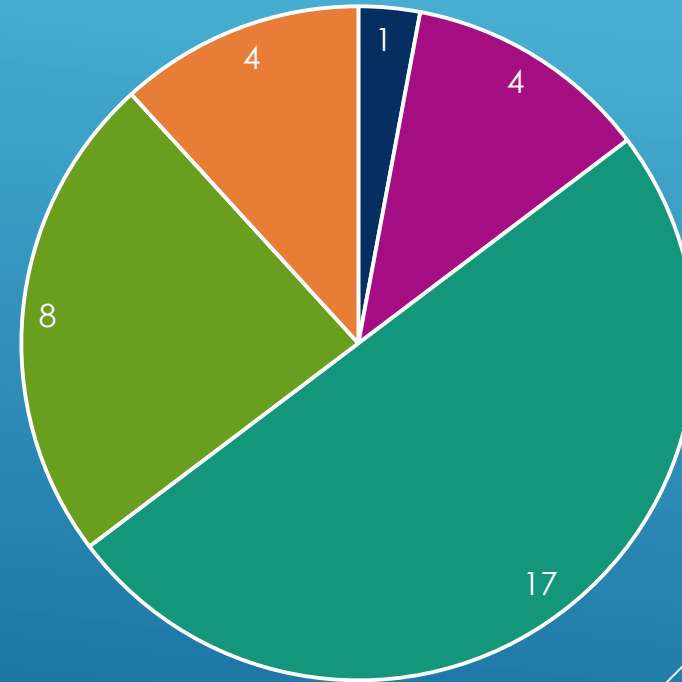

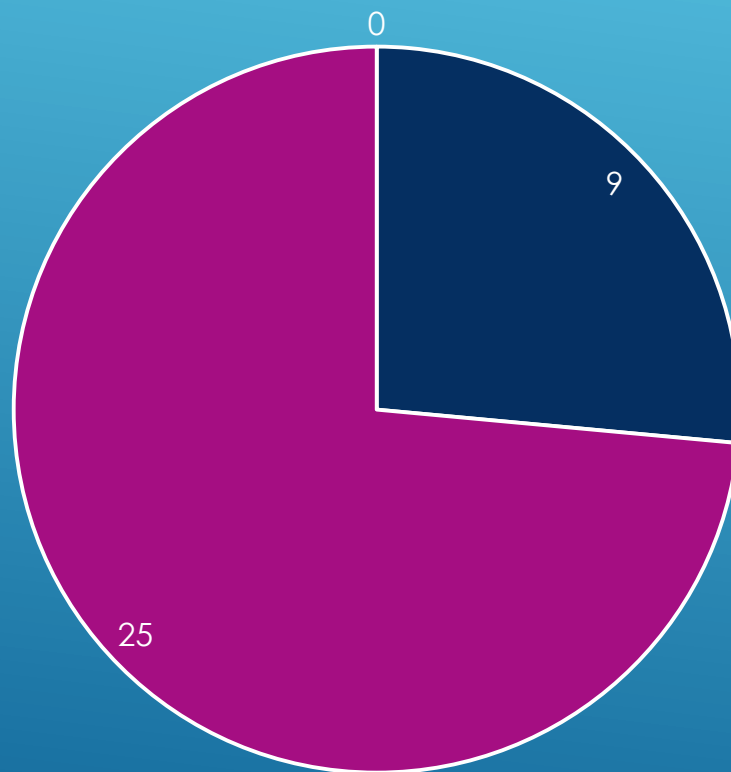

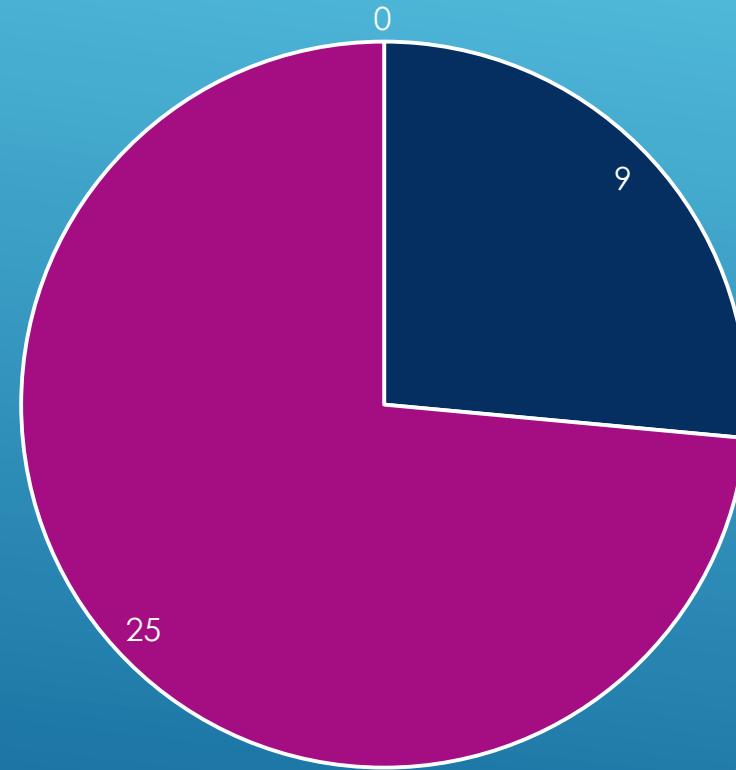

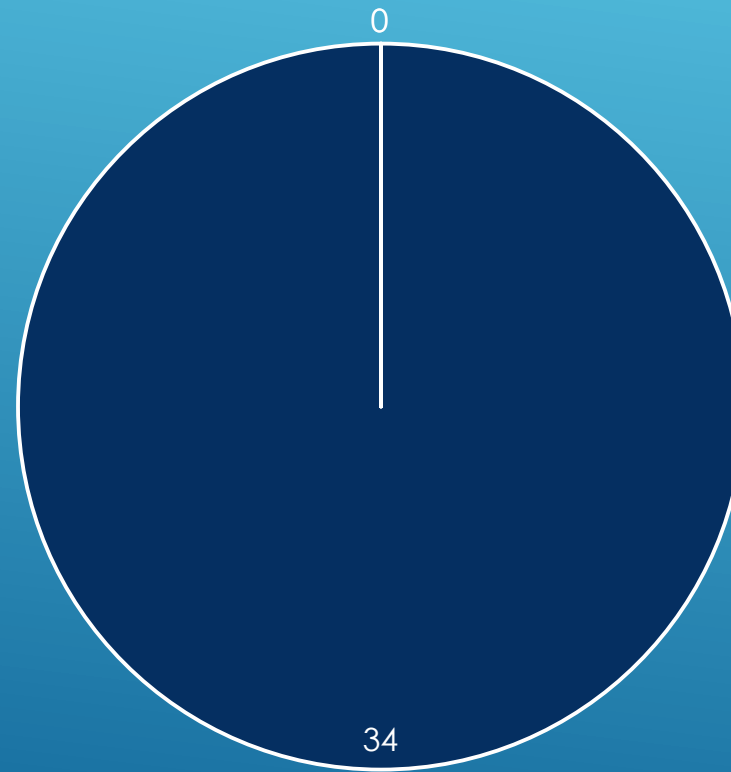

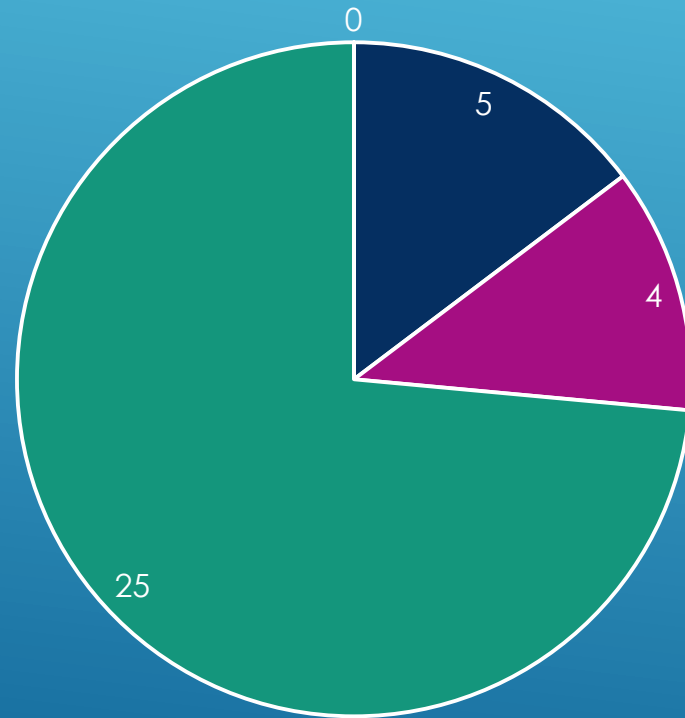

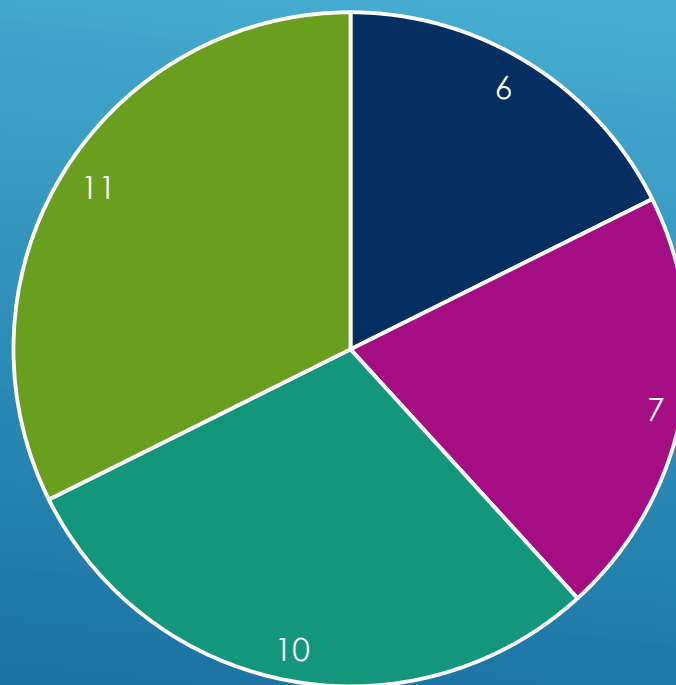
8. DO ETHNIC MINORITIES SUFFER FROM DISCRIMINATION IN YOUR COUNTRY?

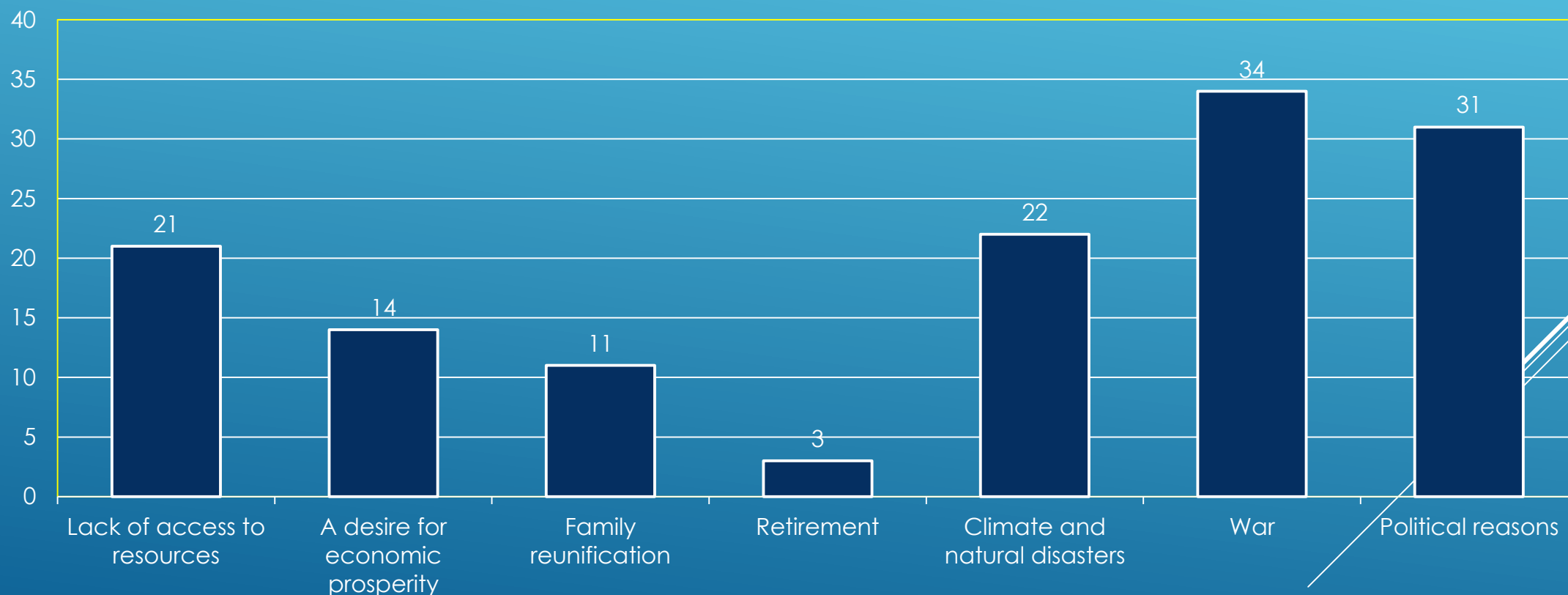

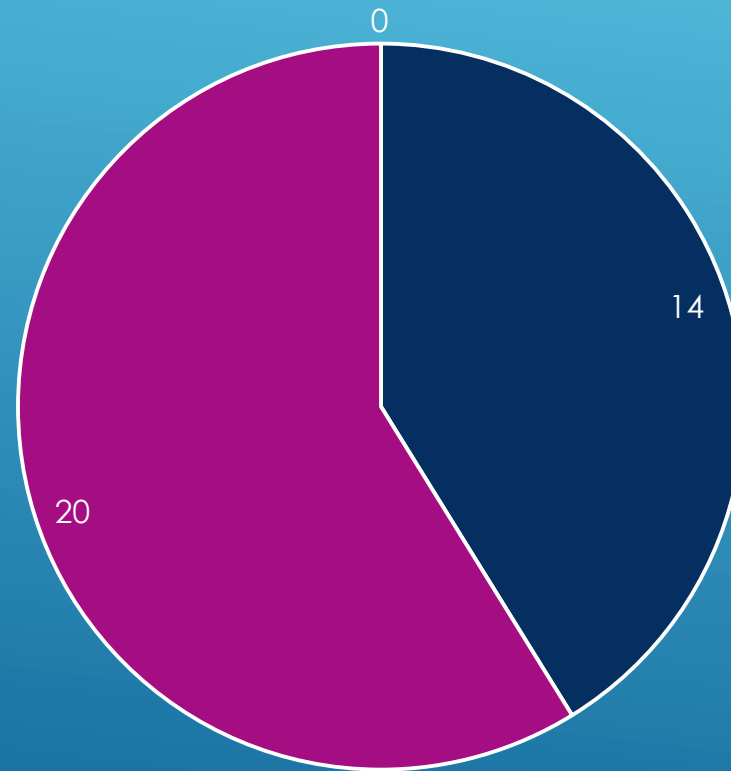

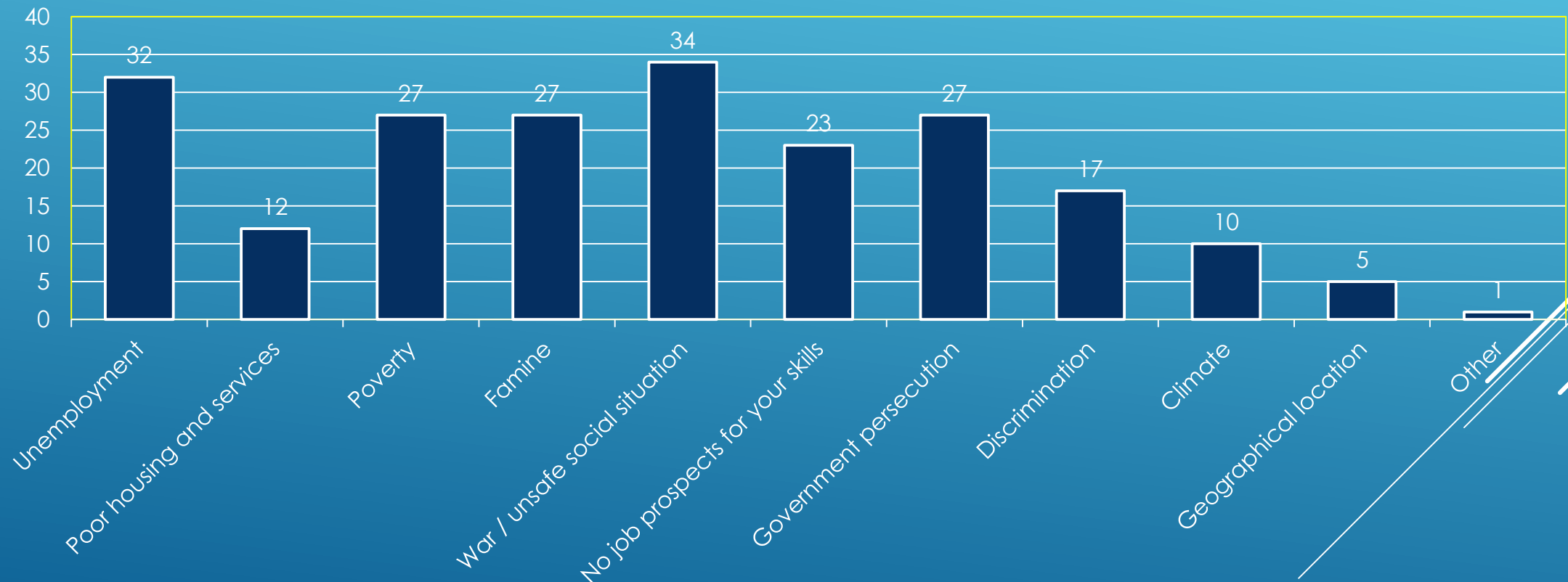
10. WAS A MEMBER OF YOUR FAMILY (LAST 3 GENERATIONS) AN IMMIGRANT?

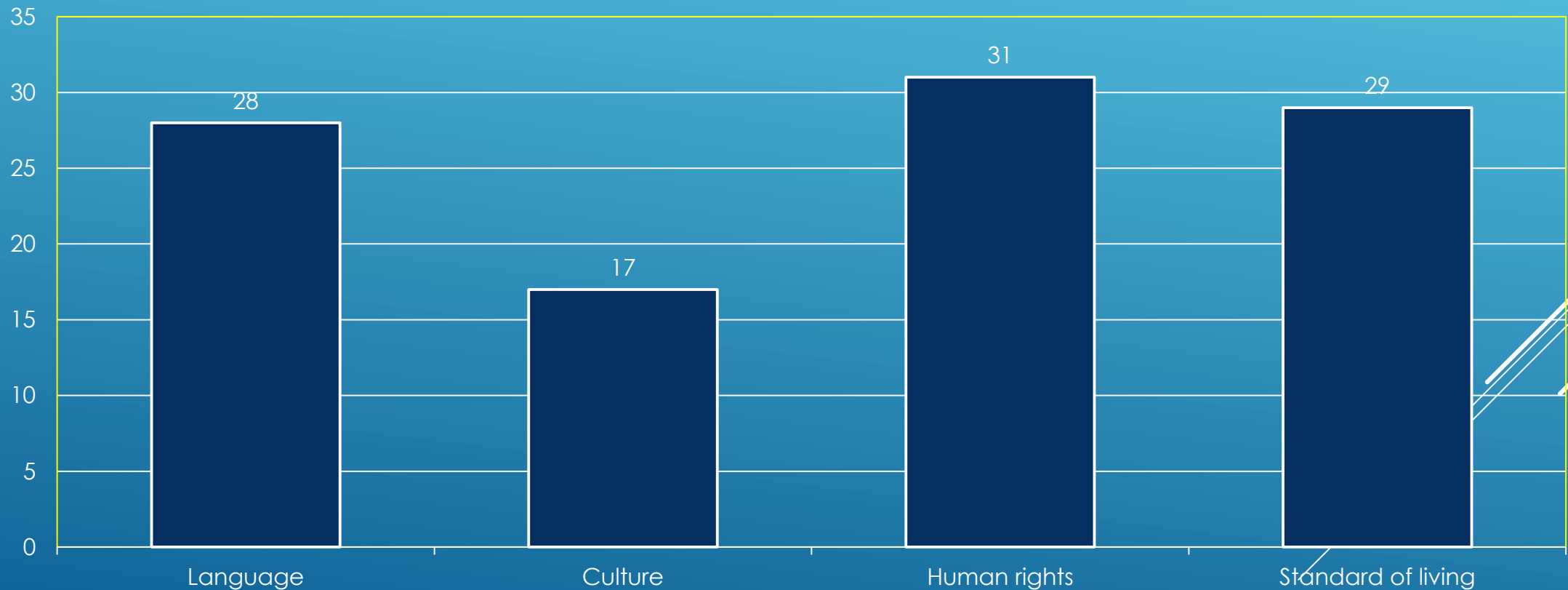

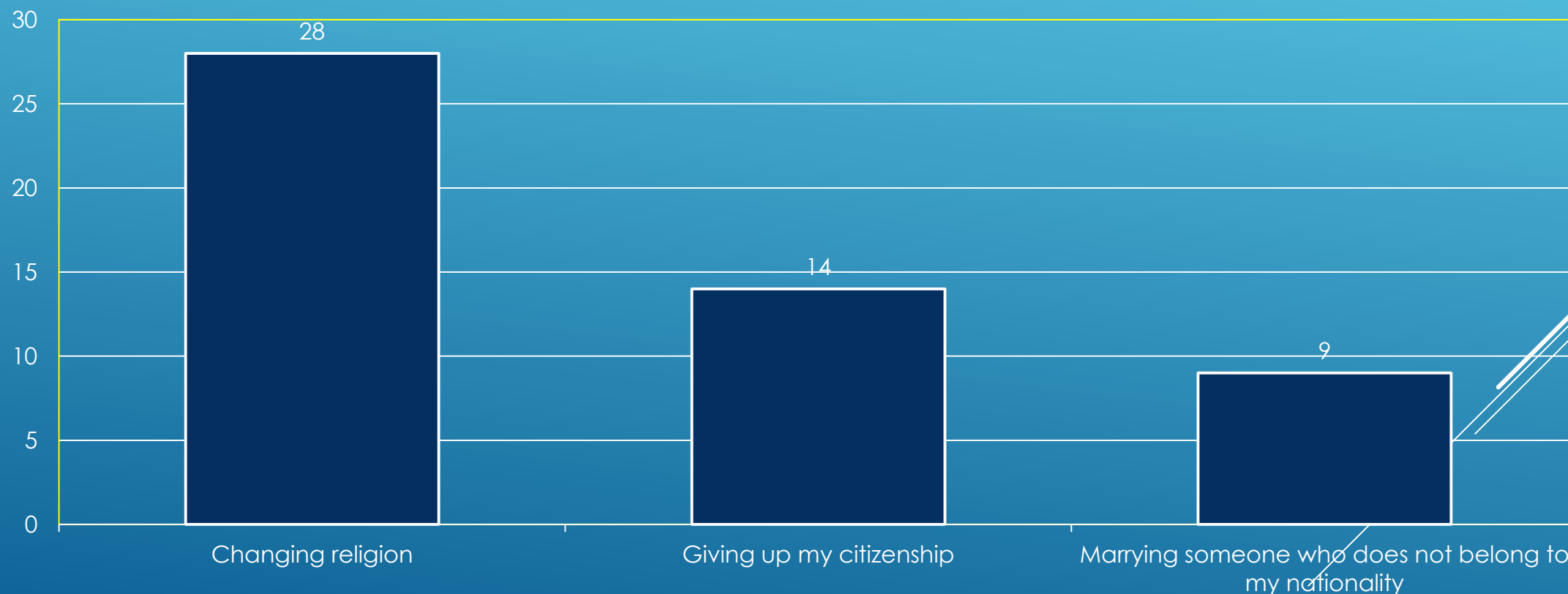

12. WHAT WOULD BE SOME OF THE ISSUES THAT WOULD CONCERN YOU ABOUT EMIGRATING?

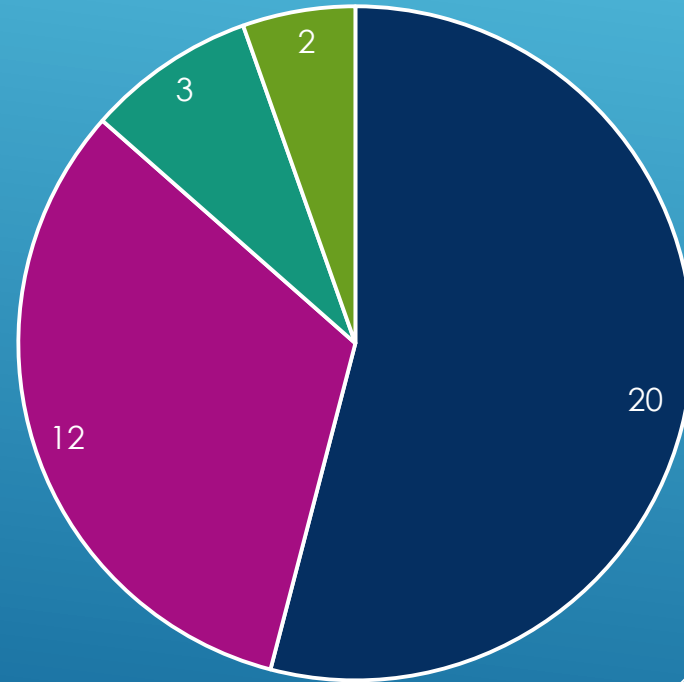
