The Castle of Olite

- It was a military castle which was built between the XIII - XIV centuries
- It was one of the main castles of the Kingdom of Navarre
- It was governed by Carlos III



The Romantic Bridge of Gares

-A great example of the architecture of the St James pilgrimage Way

-Legend says that a bird cleaned the image of the Virgin of Puy on the bridge

-The bridge was constructed by a queen, so, it has that name nowadays, Queen ´s Bridge (Puente la Reina)



St. Mary of Eunate

- In this village it was built one of the most beautiful churches in the Basque Country and the whole St. James Way
- The church was constructed in the XIIIth century
- It is famous because it is surrounded by a perfect octagon-shaped wall



Iruña or Pamplona

- Iruña is the capital of Navarre and the biggest city of our community
- In Iruña every year we celebrate 'San Fermin', a very famous fiesta
- The old part of Iruña still maintains the shape of the three medieval bourgs.
