

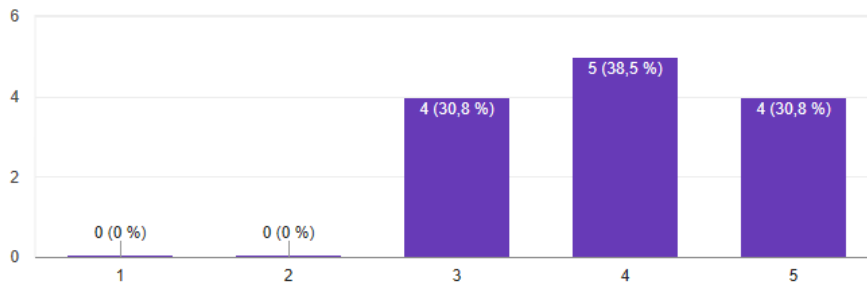
## Project evaluation survey conclusions

### Answers to the questions

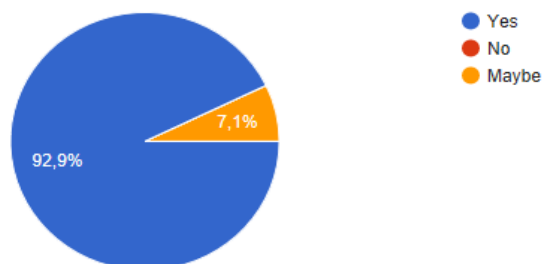
Do you think the theme of the project was interesting?

13 respuestas



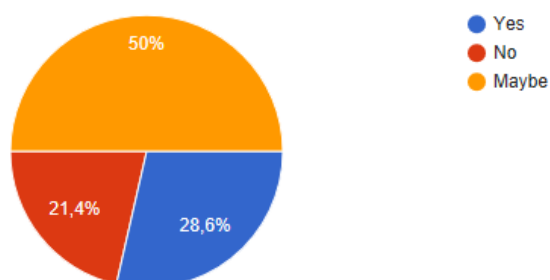
Do you think has made more attractive the project the fact that it has been carried out together with students from other countries?

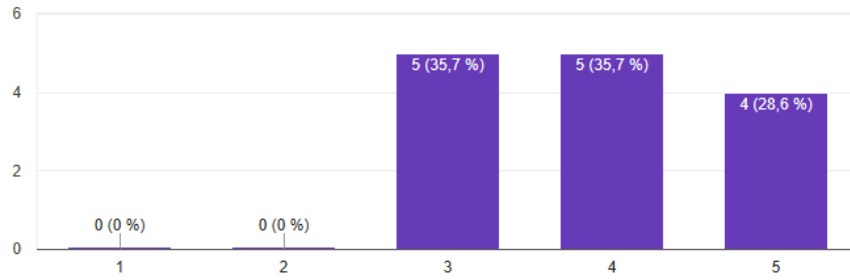
Do you think that the project has managed to encourage your taste for reading?

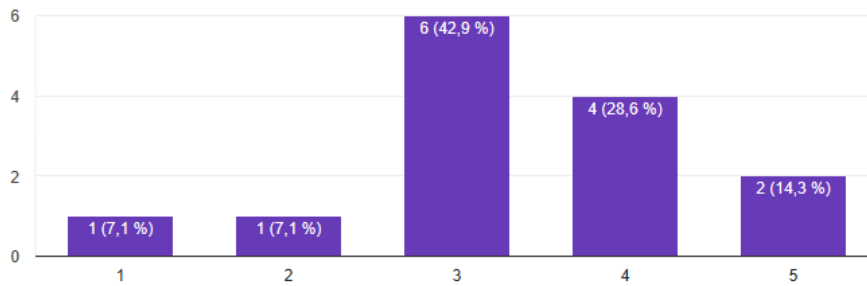
Do you consider that the activities proposed have been suitable?

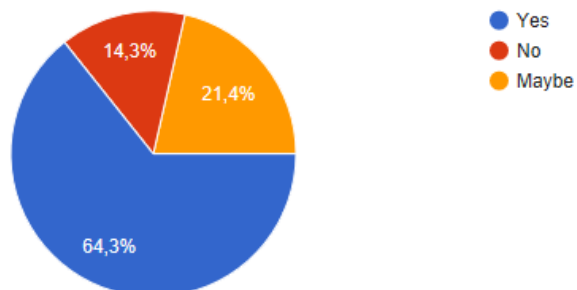
You have found attractive the readings that have been made in the project?

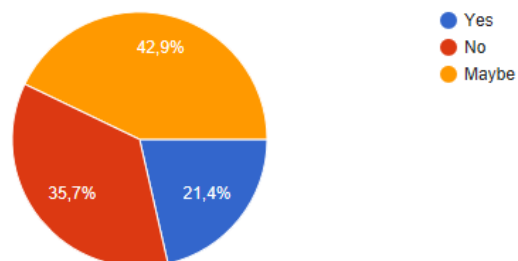
Do you think this project has made the school library more known among the students?

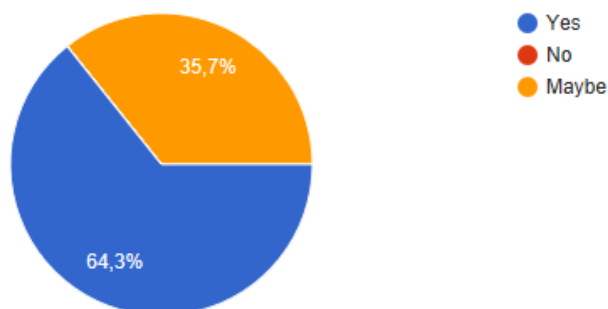
Do you think this project has improved your reading and writing skills?

To the question "which part of the project did you enjoy the most?" the most chosen options have been: presentation about Odyssey, google map, Odysseus syndrome and refugees and presenting school library.

Almost 80 percent of the students consider that this project has extended their knowledge about common cultural heritage and 50 percent considered that it has contributed to improve their level of English.

To the question "On what topic would you like the readings to be addressed in a future project?" Some of the answers have been: culture and customs of other countries, mythology, problems of youth.

Communication with colleagues has been through the Twin Space, Wahtsapp or the collaborative documents.

**Regarding aspects to be improved**

Most of them consider that more opportunities for direct communication should be found: video conferences etc ... They would have liked to make more videos and do some work on modern literature.

**General conclusions**

The students have generally considered the experience very positive, they have found the proposed activities and readings attractive, although they would also have liked to read a book of contemporary literature. They consider that they have improved their level of English and have learned about the common cultural heritage with other countries. They are not sure if their taste for reading has increased and they would have liked to have more direct communication with partners of the other countries.
