



The Emelwerda College is a large protestant comprehensive school, with about 1500 students and a teacher and teachers'supporting staff of 175, in one of the youngest Dutch provinces, Flevoland. Flevoland is a so-called polder: land, recovered from the sea . That's why the name of this school is so characteristic: "werda"= a high piece of land offering safety against the "emel", i.e. the water round the land. In this way the Emelwerda College tries to offer pupils a safe haven among the turbulent waters surrounding them.

The school is located in Emmeloord, which is the oldestcity of Flevoland. The school takes the challenge to help students develop their talents at heart. The school offers all different kinds of secondary education, given in the Netherlands.

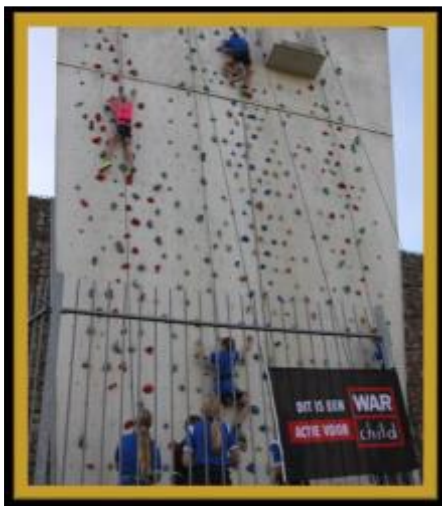
Since schoolyear 2015 the vocational department of the school, chosen to participate in this project, started a collaboration with another Dutch school (Zuyderzee College) and got a new name:

The school is provided with well equipped practice rooms and classrooms for the other subjects like for example Dutch, English, Mathematics, Social Studies, Religious and Ethical Education, Biology and PE.
