LÜGANUSE KESKKOOL

Our schoolhouse was actually built in 1694 as a manor house, which was burned down.



The current building was erected in 1926 on the foundation of the wooden manor house. It is situated in Lüganuse, which is a municipality in Ida-Viru County (137 km from Tallinn, the capital, and 73 km from Narva, a border town).

There are 91 students and 23 teachers in the school. The most important person in the school is the cook, who makes the best food in the area. The school offers primary, basic, and secondary education, so the ages of the students range from 7 to 19.
