Sunday 11.02.2108

Everybody arrived at Tallinn airport at different times. The first ones to arrive were Latvians, who then had a good time shopping and they were picked up from Ylemiste shopping centre. The next ones were the Netherlands and then came Norway. They all were picked up at Tallinn airport. Some Estonian host students came along to meet their guests. We all sat on a bus and started our ride towards Lyganuse. On our way we made a stop at Viitna for eating dinner.

In Narva we visited Narva Castle, where the guide gave us a short overview about Estonian history. All our guests had a walk around the castle and enjoyed the spectacular view to Russia.





After visiting the castle, we went to the nice restaurant, where we ate typical Russian fooddumplings and pancakes. Then we said goodbye to Narva and headed back towards Lyganuse. On our way we visited Valaste waterfall, that is the highest waterfall in Estonia.



Late in the afternoon we arrived at school again and the students went to their hostfamilies. They gathered into one host home and had a good time together playing board games and cards.

Teachers visited Vasta Manor and had a workshop about ICT, learning games and quizes. After that we had a lovely healthy dinner made by the headmistress of that school.

At 8.00 everybody arrived at school where we had presentations and videos about one healthy dish. Then teachers had their first meeting and students prepared healthy salads, in mixed groups. Afterwards teachers and students tasted these salads and voted for the best one.





After lunch we went to a Tagavälja farm, where we fed farm animals, had a sleigh ride and did a lot of Shrove Tuesday activities. Finally we went indoors, where the hostess told us about Estonian breadmaking traditions. She demonstrated how to make this kind of black

bread. After that she started making butter from cream and the students could help her. In the end, she sliced bread and everybody could taste it with the butter and honey.






Then the students went back to their hostfamilies. After eating dinner they went to the Pyssi youth club and watched films there.
