The Wounded Angel (Finnish: Haavoittunut enkeli) is a painting made by Hugo Simberg in 1903. The artist painted this artwork while recovering from a difficult disease and it is thought that the angel represents him and his feelings through his disease. The artwork is owned by Finland's National gallery and is located in the Ateneum art museum in Helsinki. The Wounded Angel was voted as Finland's national painting in a vote held by The Ateneum in 2006.
