Las Meninas is an oil painting by the Spanish painter Diego de Velázquez shown in the Museo del Padro in Madrid painted in 1656. "Menina" means "lady-inwaiting" or "Maid of Honour", i.e. a girl who serves in a royal court. There is a lot of details in the painting which makes it complicated especially on who is looking at who, at one another or at the viewer and why they are standing there. The setting is a large room in the Madrid palace of King Phillip IV of Spain.
