

Heritage Challenge

The Atomium in Brussels is one of Belgium's most famous landmarks. The Atomium was constructed for the first post-war universal world exhibition (EXPO 58). The nine spheres represent an iron crystal. It consists of 9 identical spheres joined by two types of cylindrical pipes.

The Atomium is shaped like a cube on its tip and represents an iron unit cell (9 iron atoms) magnified 165 billion times. With your teammates build the atomium with toothpicks and plasticine within 5 minutes.
