

Tipasa is located 70 km west of Algiers by the Mediterranean Sea,. It is a serial property comprising three sites: two archaeological parks located near the present urban complex and the Royal Mauritanian Mausoleum, on the west Sahel plateau of Algiers

Tipasa was an ancient Punic trading-post conquered by Rome and turned into a strategic base for the conquest of the kingdoms of Mauritania. It comprises a unique group of Phoenician, Roman, palaeochristian and Byzantine ruins alongside indigenous monuments such as the Kbor er Roumia, the great royal mausoleum of Mauretania
