In many old houses we can see the coat of arms of the family on the façade of the house. That means that the family bolonged to nobility.

The stone is a type of local granite stone called "molinaza". It has a typical reddish colour, which gives its characteristic colour to the town.

This stone was used to build the mills, hence its name, molino = mill
