Troodos

- On the 22nd of March, we went on an excursion to the snowy mountains of Troodos. Firstly, we stopped for breakfast in Evrychou . Then, we visited the Troodos Botanical Garden, the Troodos Visitor Centre and after lunch we visited the copper mines that were working in Cyprus a long time ago.
- We had great fun while playing with the snow. We also made a small snowman! Afterwards, we had a guided tour of the Visitor Centre, which taught us a lot about the geology of Cyprus. All in all, it was very interesting.
