There is also Romano Germanic Museum there, which is worth seeing too.

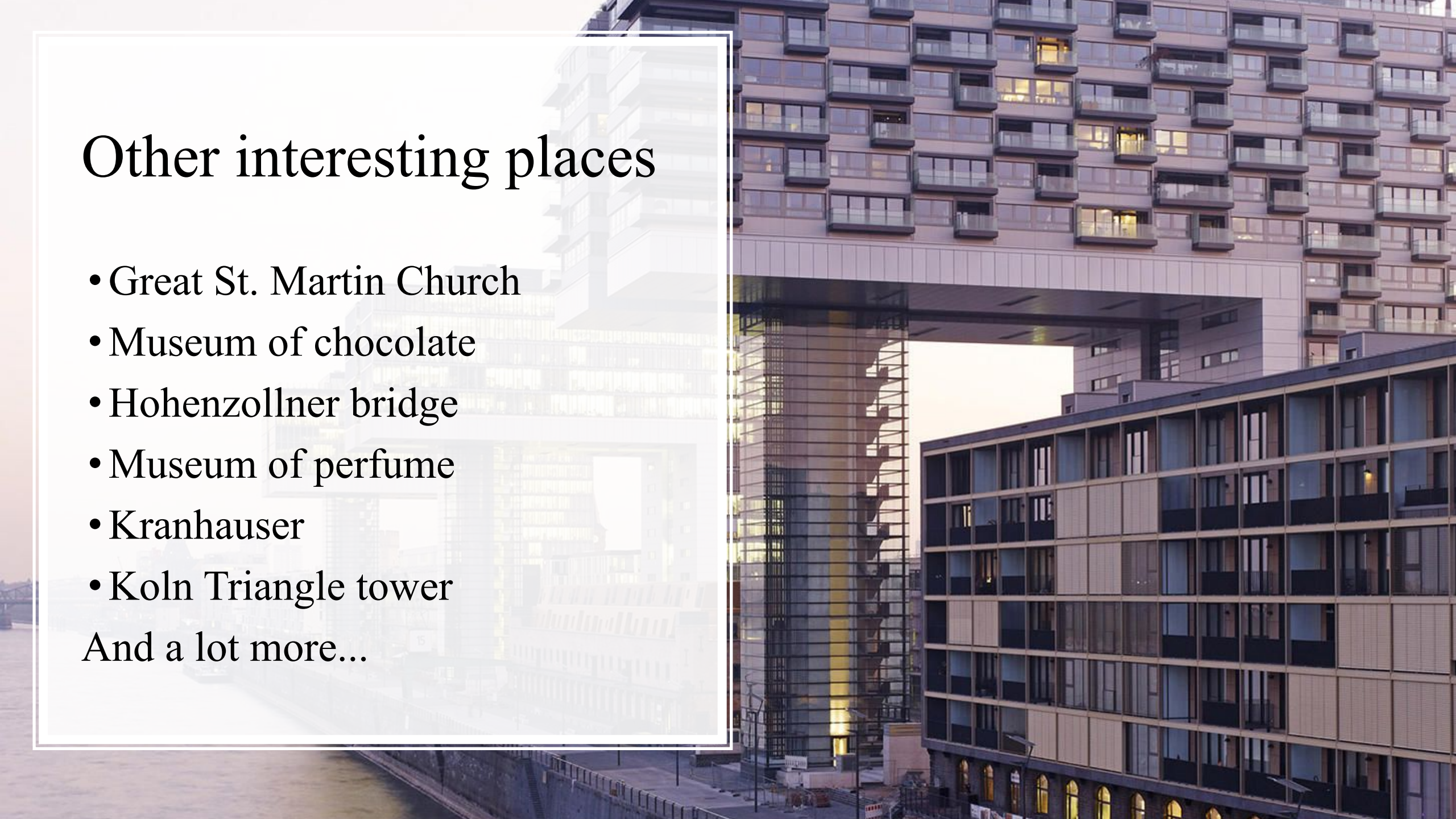

History

Cologne is one of the oldest towns in Germany and was founded in 1st century. In 1475 town was formally made a free imperial city. In 18th century, city was taken over by France, and in 19th century was attached to Prussia. In World war II was heavily bombed. After the end of the war town was rebuilt.

- It took 632 years to build the Cologne Cathedral
