# Cathedral in Cologne

---

- The most important attraction in the city is the gothic Cathedral, which, apart from visiting the temple itself, also allows you to see the city in the mountains, thanks to the possibility of entering the church's church. In addition, we can also go to the Cathedral's treasury.

# Wallraf-Richartz- Museum & Fondation Corboud

- Interesting places to visit include the Wallraf-Richartz-Museum & Fondation Corboud, one of the largest museums in Germany (one of the largest collections of medieval painting in Europe). There are valuable collections of paintings and graphics from the Middle Ages to the interwar period.



# Roman- Germanic Museum

---

- Another place with valuable monuments is the Roman-Germanic Museum (Römisch-Germanisches-Museum), where we can admire the fantastic Roman floor mosaic (with scenes from the life of Dionysus) and archaeological collections from prehistoric times to the Middle Ages from the city and its surroundings. The building also houses the world's largest collection of Roman glass.



# Lindt chocolate museum

---

- There is also something for lovers of sweets. - Schokoladenmuseum - Lindt chocolate museum, where we will see, among others, how the production process of chocolates on belts in the factory looks like.
