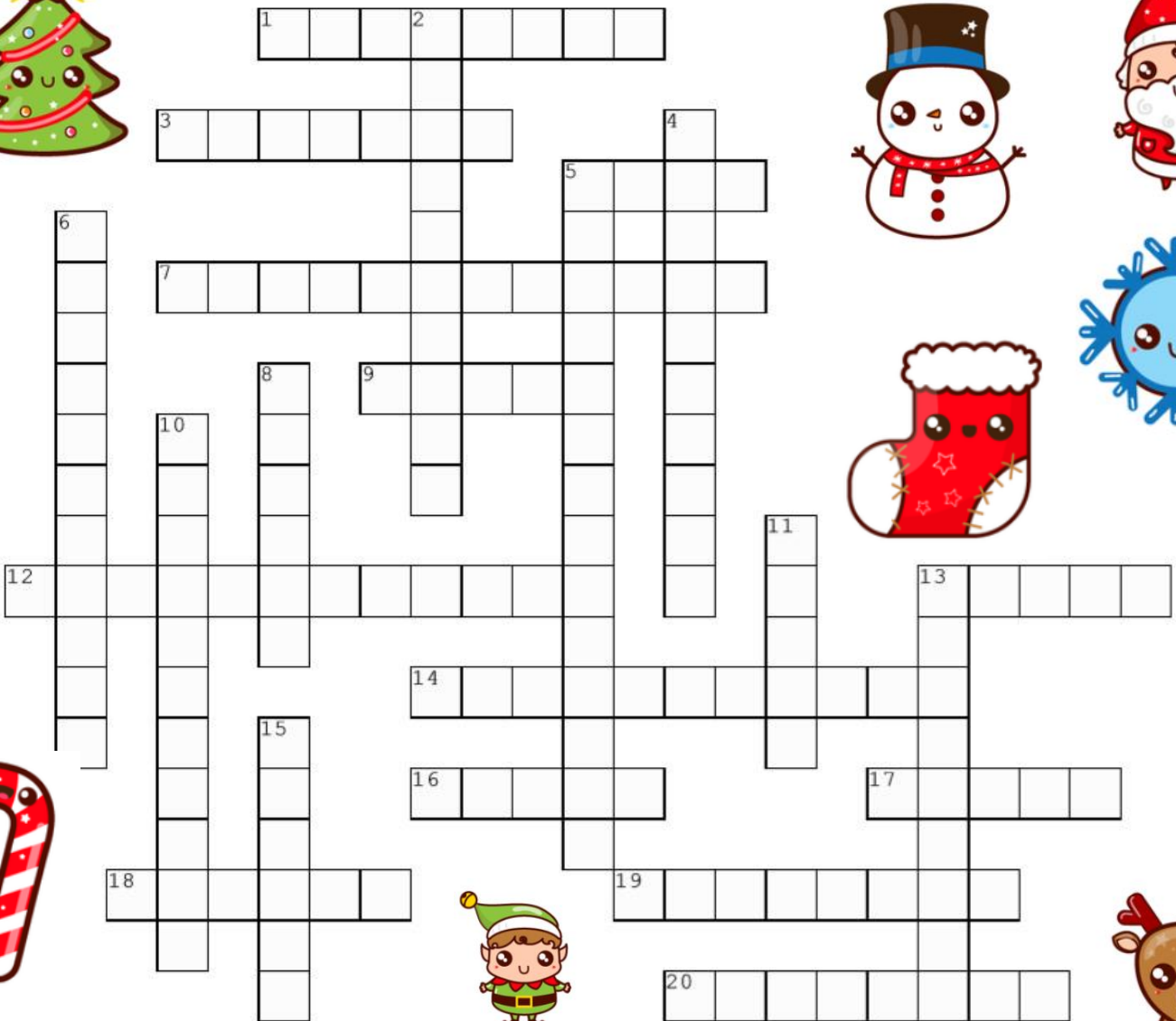


# CHRISTMAS CROSSWORD

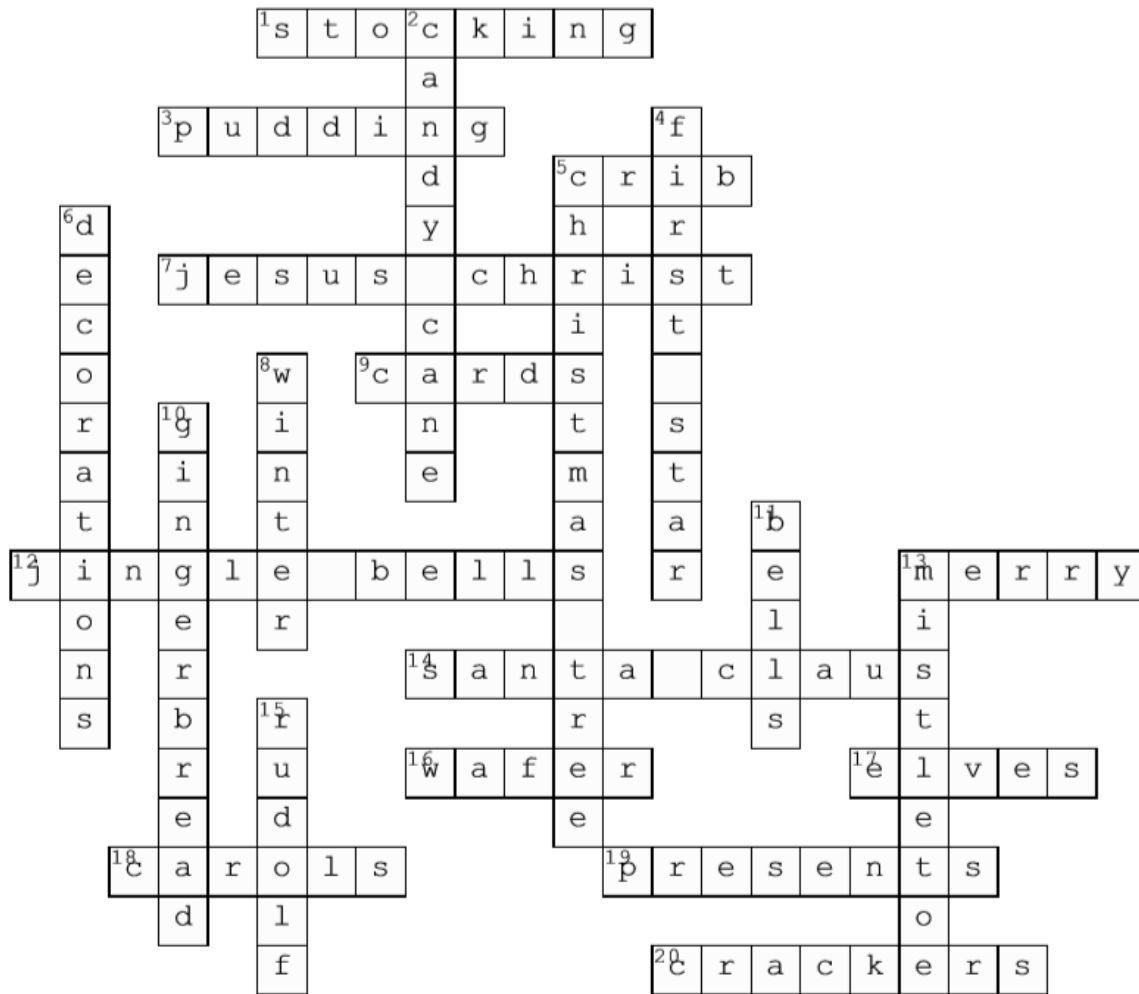
