## **Activity Title: Treasure Hunt for Cylinders by Charmaine Attard from Malta**

<u>Theme:</u> Cylinder Systems <u>Month</u>: December

<u>Aim:</u> To enhance awareness about objects in our daily life that have cylinder shapes while improving pre-writing skills while taking a tally count on a whiteboard.

<u>Resources/Materials needed:</u> whiteboard, whiteboard marker, cylinder shapes, location (outdoor/indoor etc)

## **Activity:**

<u>Step 1:</u> <u>Introduction:</u> Present students with different cylinders and ask them why are they useful in our daily life.

**Step 2:** Give students a whiteboard each (or per group) and take them to a location to seek for cylinders around them. (in the school yard, classroom, gymnasium etc etc).

Step 3: Allow students to take pictures of their findings to help them evaluate and remember later.

<u>Step 4</u>: Check the tally boards and count how many cylinders you managed to find around your location/s.
