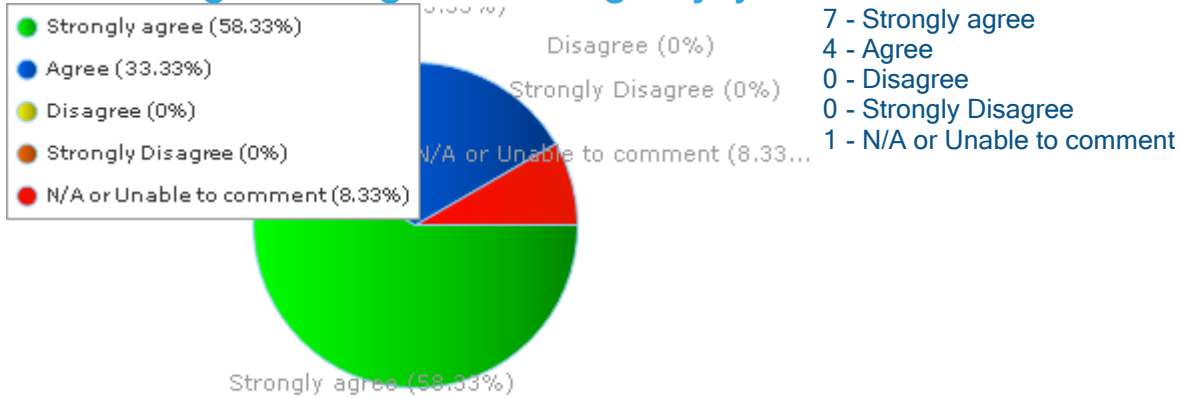

My participation in the project so far is interesting/exciting/rewarding/enjoyable

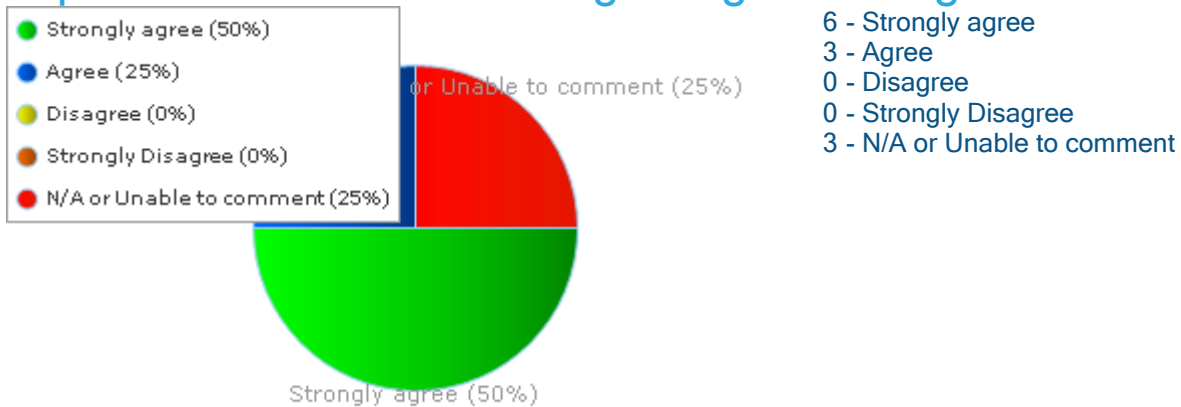


I have absolutely loved getting to know the teachers from the other 5 partner countries

It has been our first experience of Erasmus and it has been fantastic

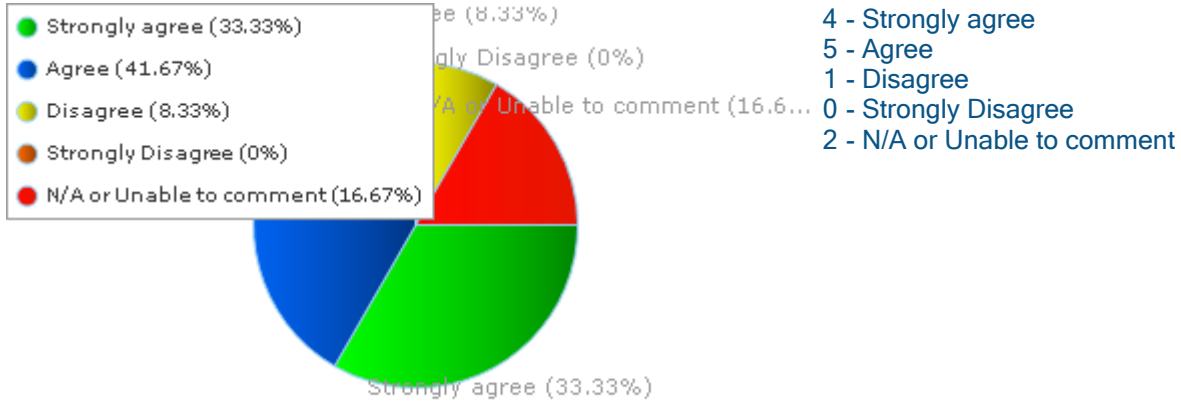
Fantastic opportunity for children and school staff to share learning within their own school setting as well as internationally

The project has enabled me to further develop professionally/ learn new skills

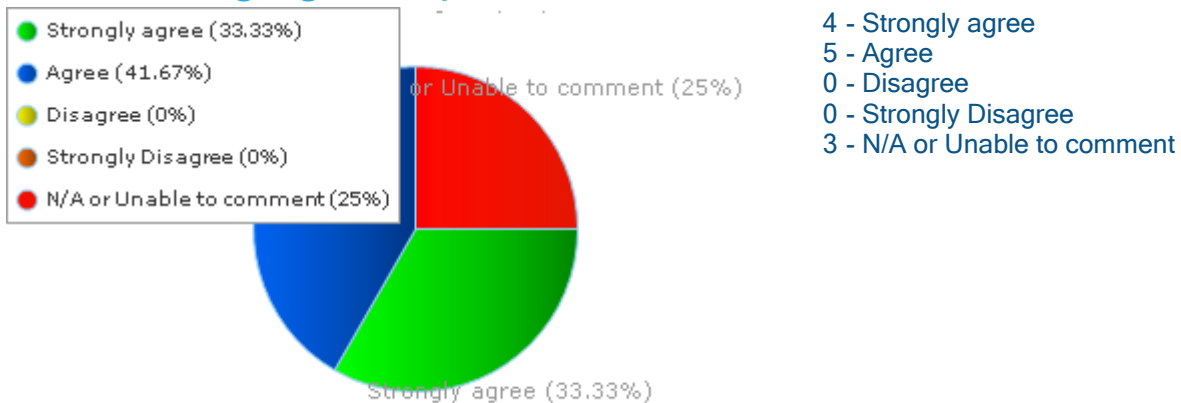


I have HAD to learn twinspace so I could teach my children!

I am managing to implement the activities on time

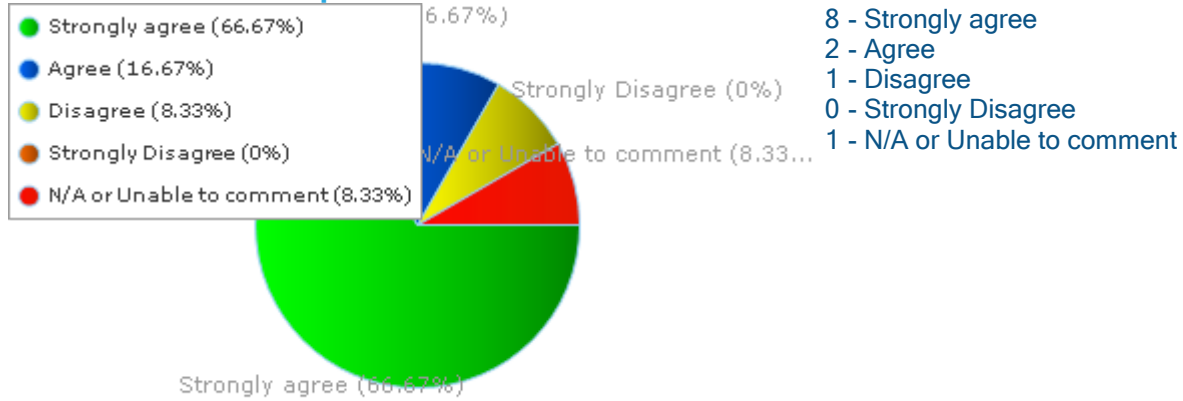


Clear timetable shared in advance is really helpful

On the whole although it IS a struggle sometimes

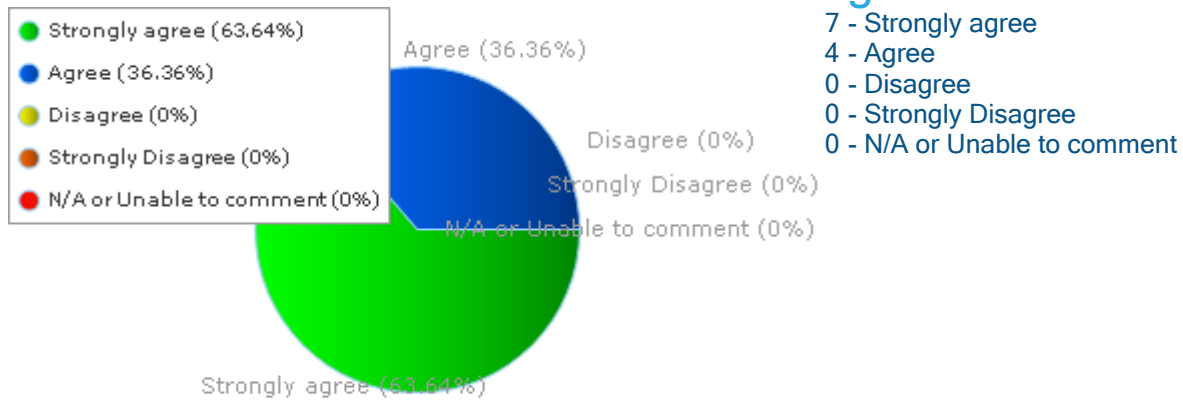
On the whole yes - but I am glad I am nagged to keep up with the other countries by my Greek counsellor from Little Hadham

The communication between the coordinators and the staff is effective. I am provided with sufficient information

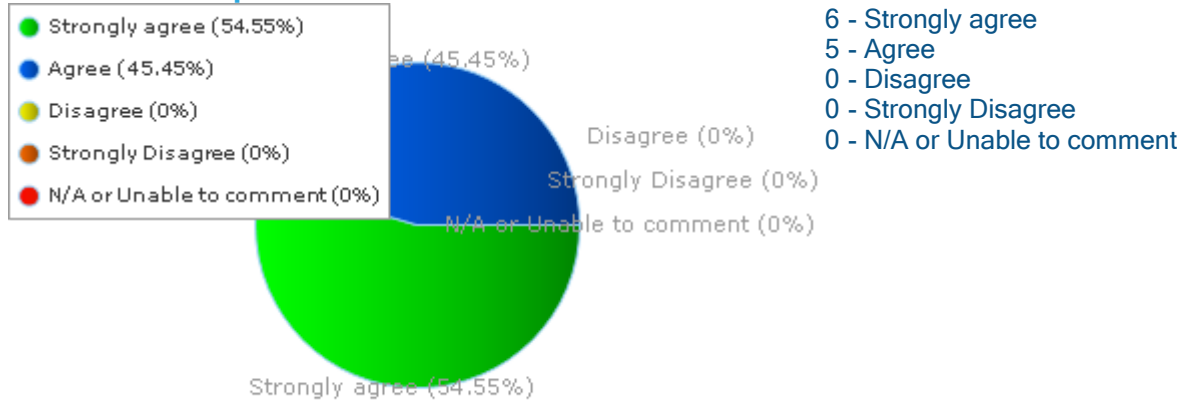


Always kept up to date and informed with next part of the project and visits

The project includes the involvement of all the teachers in the school. I have been informed about the goals and activities

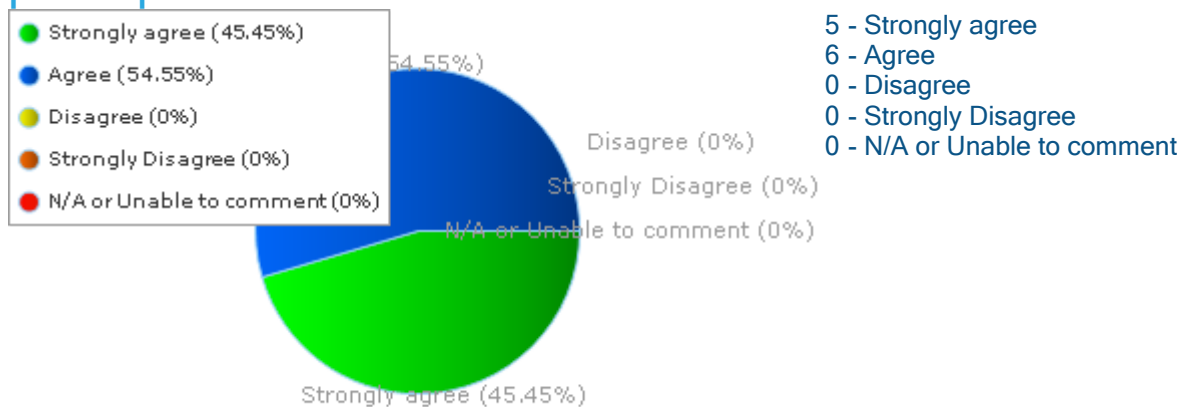


The project includes the involvement of all the children in the school. Pupils are aware of the whole school focus

The project involves the involvement of the community. Parents have been informed about the project, the activities (through website, App or letters) and have sometimes been asked to participate

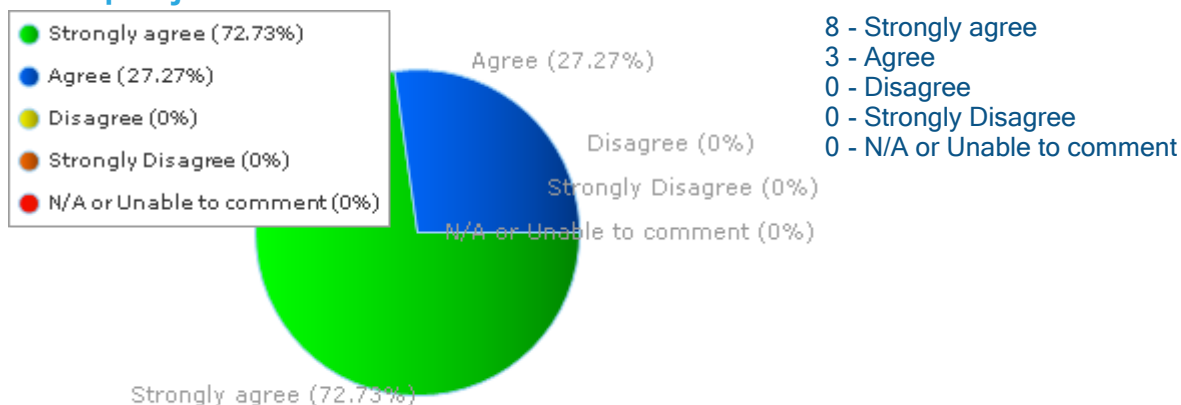


We had all parents and Governors involved at some point - particularly when we hosted and for our charity push with shoes
