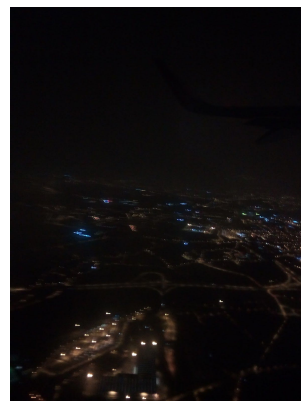


Erasmus+ Poland

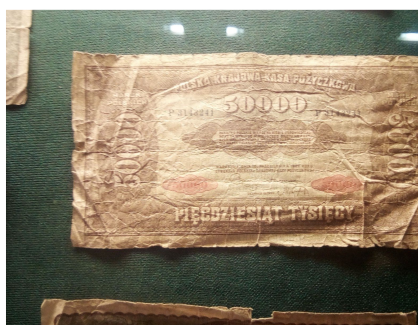
Day "0": (Sunday 22/09)

- Meeting **Sulmierzyce** was fantastic!



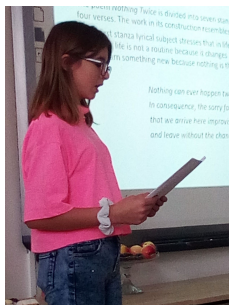
Day 2: (Tuesday 24/09)

- It was a delicious and colorful experience!



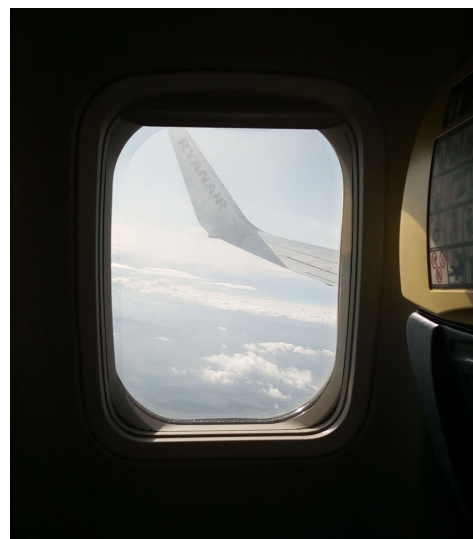
Day 5: (Friday 27/09)
