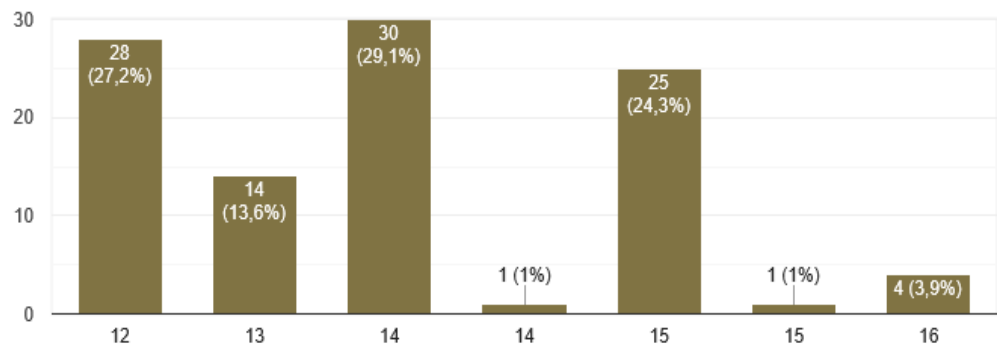


Questionnaire results with notes

103 answers

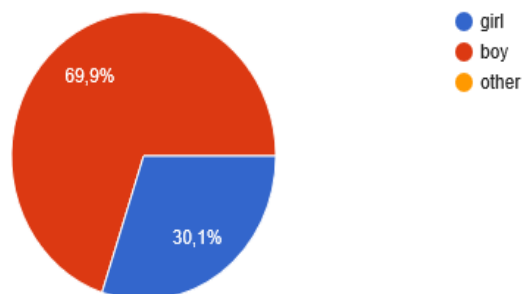
- The total number of respondents is 103

- 31 girls

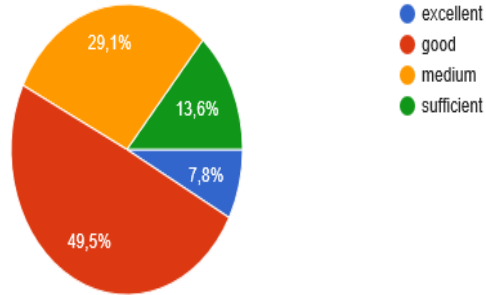


Study results

- medium 30 (29,1%)
- sufficient 14 (13,6%)
- excellent 8 (7,8%)

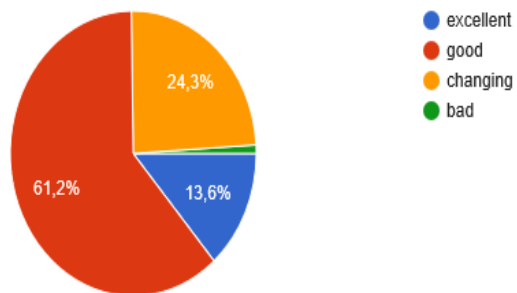


Behaviour

Diligence

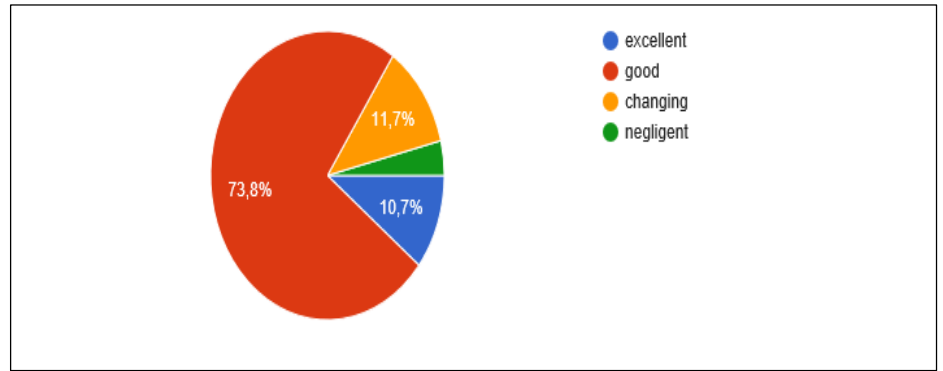
103 answers

Atmosphere

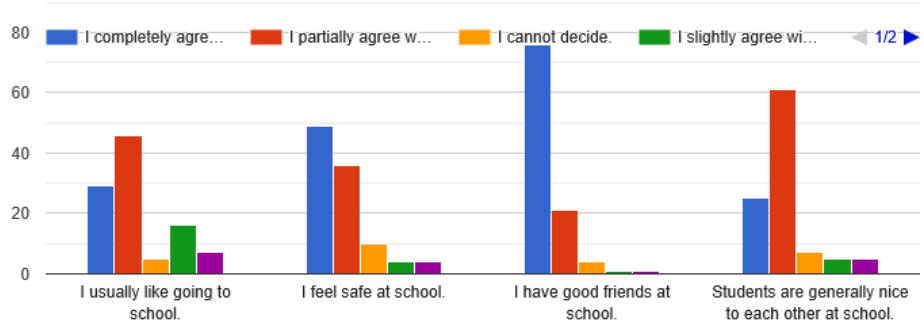
Characterize the following statements according to how you agree with it!

76 have good friends at school

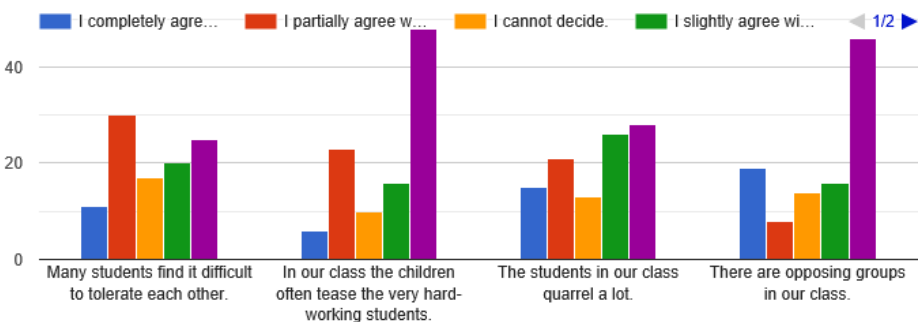
61 are generally nice to each other at school

15 only think that in their class the students quarrel a lot



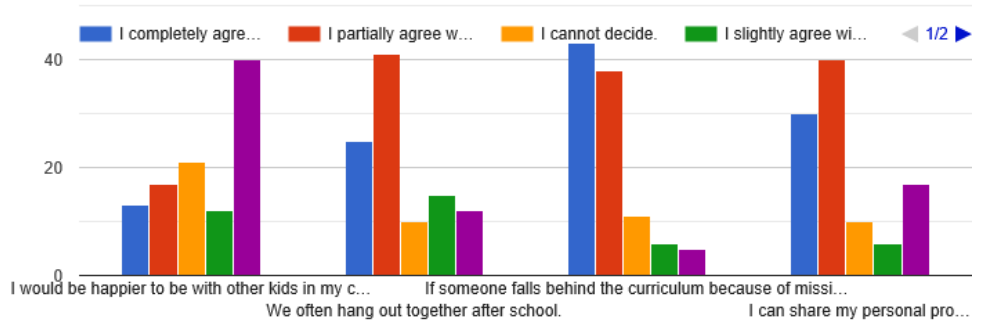
46 reflect that there are opposing group in the class

43 can count on the other's help

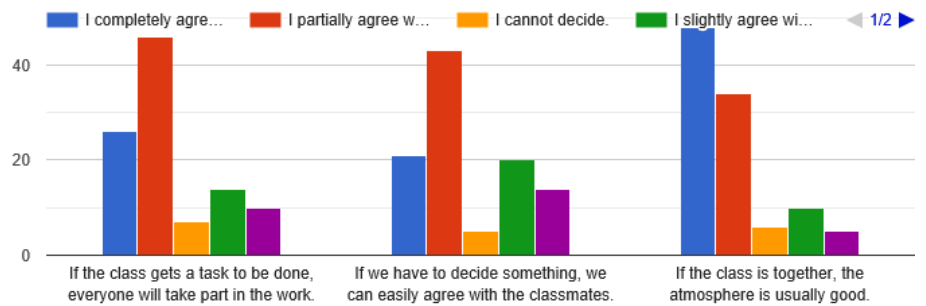
30 can share their personal problems with their classmates

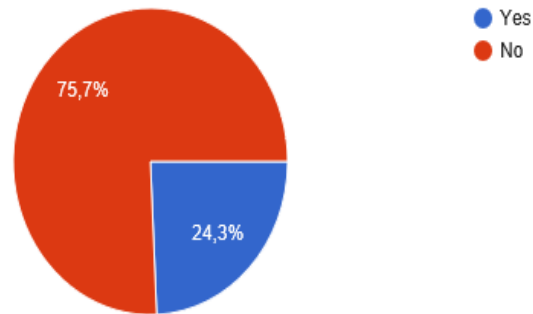
III. Have you ever been in a conflict at school that you could not solve and it made your life more difficult?

Solving a conflict

If you or any of your mates are in a conflict, how do you usually try to solve it?

The most common way to solve conflicts is to talk to friends and try to figure something out 60 (60.2%)

24 (23.3%) ask an adult for help

Only 17 (16.5%) solve it byself
