Rosaleda Stadium Visit

La Rosaleda Stadium, located in Paseo de Martiricos, and has been the home of football in Malaga since its official opening on the 14th of September 1941 for a match between CD Málaga - Seville FC. For 70 years, La Rosaleda has hosted league matches, the Copa del Rey, UEFA Champions League matches, nine matches of the Spanish national team and three matches of the group stage of the 1982 World Cup in Spain against Scotland, New Zealand and the former Soviet Union. The stadium features a museum telling the story of the best moments in the history of the Malaga team. During their visit to the stadium, the group will have the opportunity to visit the museum, the history corridor, the Malaga team's history stages, the VIP arena, the grandstands, the press room, the history room, the cloakroom and, of course, the pitch.

Olive Oil Mill Tour

After sampling the goods, you'll be free to explore the stunning grounds with your group, take pictures and ask questions, before leaving with goodies from their gift shop in-hand, so you can take their products home for your loved ones to try (or keep it to yourself... we won't judge!)

Day trips

Day trip to Cordoba

Premium: visit to the Mosque

Cordoba is a large Andalusian town on the banks of the Guadalquivir River. Over the centuries, this area has been occupied by successive cultures, and each of them has left its mark here. It is worth taking a trip here to discover this cultural richness.

The Mezquita Mosque in Cordoba - La Catedral Mezquita - is a unique temple. The area where the Cathedral stands, has been a place of worship of various deities since ancient times. On the Roman ruins stood Visigoth church, which in the 8th century was taken over by the Arab rulers and became the main mosque of the city and the largest mosque in Europe.

In the 13th century, La Mezquita was transformed into a Catholic cathedral. The architecture of the building shows this unusual cultural combination, where among the unique double Arabic arches, from the middle of the Islamic temple supposedly grows a Christian cathedral.

The premium price option includes a ticket to visit the impressive La Catedral Mezquita mosque.





Day trip to Ronda

Premium: Bullring Arena

Ronda is one of the most impressive places in Spain. Although it is a small town, it enchants with its amazing location on the edge of a wide, almost 70-meter deep canyon with a depth of 120 meters. The magnificent neighborhood has inspired many writers and artists, and undoubtedly continues to impress visitors. During the tour you will be able to visit the most important attractions of the city, including the famous bridge over the aforementioned canyon.

A premium option is to enter the oldest bullring in Spain (certainly one of the most beautiful). The tour around the Old Town takes about 2 hours and provides great views.





Day trip to Granada

City located in the foot of Sierra Nevada, one of the most beautiful places not only in Andalusia, but in the whole Spain. It is famous for its sympathetic, welcoming people, tasty tapas served to each drink and an authentic atmosphere, which make Granada so beloved. On the hill above the city, proudly stands Alhambra, most impressive complex of palace & garden in the whole Europe, which is a great example of Arab architecture. From the palace you can admire beautiful views to the whole Granada. On the other side, walking through charming Paseo de Los Tristes, you can find Mauro district Albaicin, where you can take a walk and dive into its atmosphere. Moreover, the best end of the day of adventures in Granada will be sunset watched from Mirador San Nicolas, where the views of snowy peak of Sierra Nevada are just breathtaking, and the lighted Alhambra feels alive accompanied by the sounds of flamenco.

Granada impresses in every corner and is definitely an example of Arab and Andalusian culture. No doubts that it is a must see on Spanish map.





Day Trip Caminito del Rey

Caminito del Rey or King's Path is a great option for those who like to spend time outdoors. It delights with both views and history related to the origin of the name. Nowadays, it is one of the most interesting attractions of the Province of Malaga. The narrow limestone gorge is located in the National Park Desfiladero de los Gaitanes. The Guadalhorce River flows between the huge rocky cliffs, which are 700 metres high at their highest points. There are bridges and railway tunnels in the rocks. A picturesque trip through Desfiladero de los Gaitanes is a low difficulty hike, with a trail along steep limestone rocks that offers unique views. The King's Path was created for the needs of hydroelectric power plant workers. In 1901 a one metre wide path was created, suspended at a height of about 100 meters above the river. The name comes from the fact that in 1921 King Alfonso XII travelled this route during the opening ceremony of the Conde del Gaudalhorce dam.

This excursion provides a dose of interesting experiences, beautiful views and is a pleasant change from days spent on Andalusian beaches!





Canyoning in Río Verde

This is an amazing opportunity for adrenaline lovers! Take to the cliffs of the province of Granada on a guided canyon descent. Follow the "Rio Verde" and take in the stunning surroundings whilst scaling and abseiling rocks. Under the watchful eye of two highly qualified guides, and well protected with all of the necessary equipment and insurance, of course; you will explore the gorge and make your descent alongside the river, down cliffs and through waterfalls... all to finish off your strenuous day with a relaxing, and well deserved picnic. If you love to adventure, do outdoor activities, and don't mind getting a little wet along the way, this is an opportunity that simply can't be missed.





Trip to Cadiz

Premium: admission to Torre de Poniente

Cadiz is one of the oldest villages on the Iberian Peninsula. The first settlers appeared here as early as 3,000 years ago. Since its foundation by the Phoenicians around 1100 BC, the village has been one of the most important ports in the country.

The old town will delight you with its large open squares, narrow street networks interspersed with wide port alleys and high houses with turrets. These impressive buildings, smeared with sea air, give the city a mysterious atmosphere.

A premium option is to climb the tower (74 meters high) inside the cathedral, Torre de Poniente, where you can enjoy the most beautiful panoramic views of the city.

You have to note that the one-way trip takes almost 4 hours!





Day trip to Bologna Beach

Bologna Beach is more than just sand and crystal clear water...

It's a long and beautiful beach, very wide and with transparent water and soft golden sand. What makes it even more special is its location: it stretches between the mountains of San Bartolome and Sierra de Plata, the proximity of the ruins of the ancient city of Baelo Claudia.

It delights with its tranquility and dunes (one of them is 30 meters long!). There are no hotels or shops in the area. The beach is considered to be one of the most beautiful places in the region. If the weather is good you can even see the African coast. It is not as crowded as most beaches on the coast, as the access is much more difficult.

In 2015, the beach was ranked among the top 10 beaches in Europe and second in Spain, being awarded the "Travellers Choice" award by TripAdvisor.





Surfing Trip

What would you say if you could feel like in Hawaii?

On this trip you will have the perfect opportunity to learn how to surf. Surfing lessons are held on Palmar Beach, near Cadiz. Palmar Beach is the perfect place to have a go at water sports. Thanks to the Atlantic Ocean waves, soon you'll be able to see why people choose this place. In addition, the beautiful white sand makes Palmar beach one of the most charming beaches in Spain.





Day trip to Nerja

Premium: **canoeing**Premium: **Nerja Cave**

Nerja is a picturesque seaside town which is an ideal place for rest and relaxation on the beach. It is known for its small, charming bays, crystal clear water and favorable weather. There are also impressive caves, such as Cueva de Nerja (Nerja Cave), where you can discover numerous testimonies of the long history of this place. The caves are included in one of the premium options.

The second premium option, which is particularly suitable for water sports enthusiasts, is canoeing.





Day trip to Seville

Premium: Metropol Umbrella - viewing terrace

Seville is one of the most amazing cities in Spain. It is the artistic and cultural capital of Andalusia and the fourth largest city in Spain. Currently there are about 1.5 million people living here. The city itself is a historical and architectural masterpiece. There are many unique buildings and magnificent gardens. Subtle flowing fountains, countless patios and intricate decorations deriving from the Islamic cultural heritage. The huge cathedral, the former minaret - Giralda, the royal Alcazar, and the General archive of the Indies are all included on the UNESCO World Heritage site. Together with the Tobacco Factory, Plaza de Toros de la Maestranza - one of Spain's oldest bullfighting arenas, the Golden Tower and many, many others delight people from all over the world. The stunning Plaza de España Square was the scenery for several famous films such as "Star Wars" and "the Dictator". The creators of the popular series "Game of Thrones" also appreciated the charm of this magnificent city and showed the beauty of the Alcazar and its gardens during the scenes set in the fictional Dorne.

The premium option we offer the group is a unique walk on the Metropol Parasol observation deck. It is an astonishing construction, made entirely of wood, with a view of the entire city.





Day trip to Gibraltar

Premium: Cable Car

Gibraltar is British overseas territory. The currency is the Pound of Gibraltar and the locals speak English here. The history of the city is one of numerous wars, as it was a military base for many centuries. The name Gibraltar comes from the Arabic name of the mountain Tarkika (arab. Jabal al-Tariq). During the reconquest Gibraltar conquered Spain, but in 1704 it was taken over by the British. It is the most densely populated territory in the whole of Europe (28 000 citizens live on an area of 6.5 km²). A big tourist attraction are the monkeys living in Gibraltar, awaiting tourists. The famous Gibraltar monkeys are a tailless species of monkeys from the macaque family. It is the only species of monkey, freely living on the European continent. Although they seem sweet and innocent, don't bother them. They can bite you or steal your things!

The main part of the trip to Gibraltar is climbing the Gibraltar rock. On the way we will meet the previously mentioned macaques and will be able to admire the unforgettable views of Africa.

The premium option that we offer to the group is to ascend to the top of the rock with a cable car. This will save you a lot of time and energy and will allow you to enjoy the views from the highest point of Gibraltar for longer and with more free time in the town.





Day trip to Marbella

Marbella, this is a town and community in southern Spain. It belongs to the province of Malaga in Andalusia. It is one of the most important resorts on the Costa del Sol, which is popular the world over.

Marbella is a city of splendour, luxury and classic beauty. According to some, it is the most luxurious tourist city in Spain. There are celebrities in the city, their yachts worth millions of euros are moored in the harbor, the latest Ferrari models are bustling the streets which are lined with original Salvador Dali sculptures. The city also has archaeological and cultural heritage: the 16th century town hall, the Emita de Santiado chapel, the Church of the Encarnación, the Muralla del Castillo and the Puerto Banus Yacht Port are just a few additional reasons to visit the city, which is located on the trail commonly known as the "Golden Mile".

During the time available to the group, participants will be able to enjoy the beautiful weather on the beaches and the promenade.





Day trip to Mijas

Premium: Benalmadena + cable car

Premium: Butterfly Park

Mijas is famous for the oriental atmosphere of its former Arab village and unique eco-friendly "taxis" powered by hay. But that's not the end... There is also a wonderful miniature museum located in an old circus car. There are many peculiarities shown: a prepared missionary's head, a prayer written on the edge of a phone card, a portrait of Abraham Lincoln on a pinhead and over 300 objects more, most of which can be only seen through a magnifying glass. Additionally, you can admire breath-taking views all around you.

Benalmadena is located not very far away from Mijas (18km) and is a perfect holiday destination for its sandy beaches and beautiful promenade. From this place you can go to the historic white village (Belmadena Pueblo) or Mariposario – the Butterfly Park – where live about 1500 species of these colorful insects. Thanks to a cable car situated in the upper part of the city you can enjoy an amazing coastal landscape.


