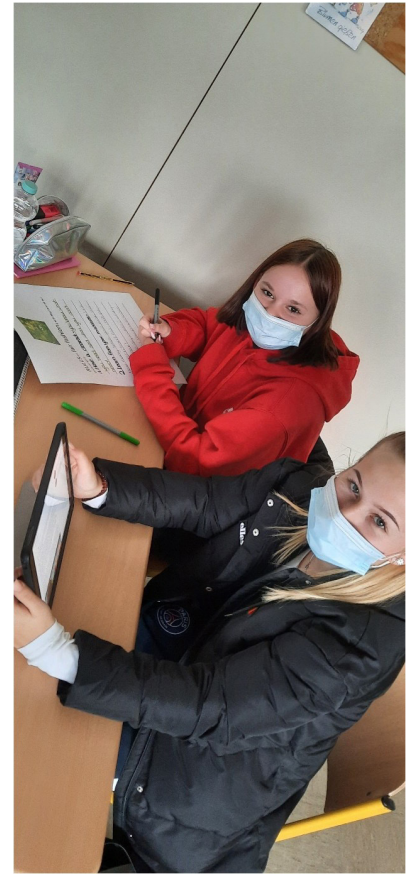
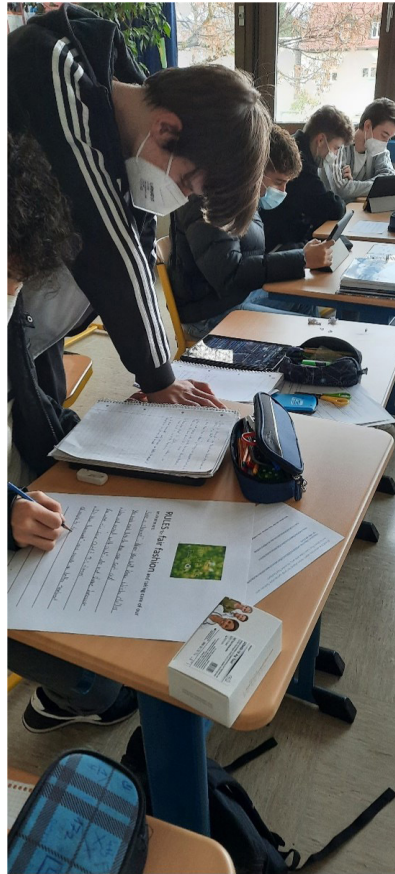


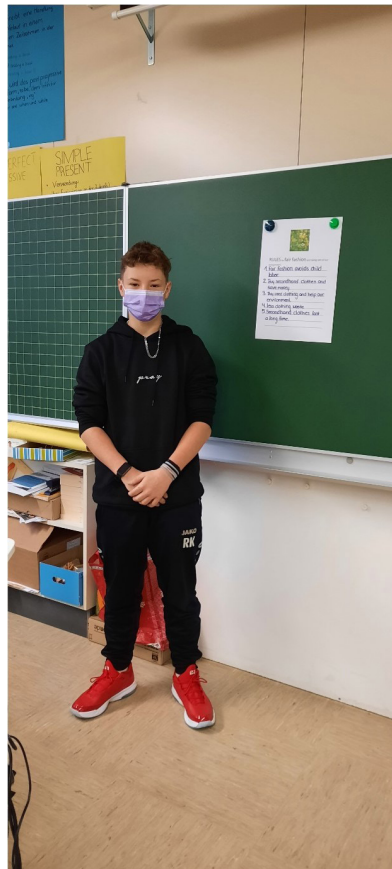
Stop fast fashion – save our environment!



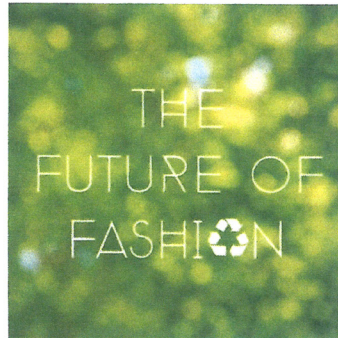

Here you see us while we were working on the posters.

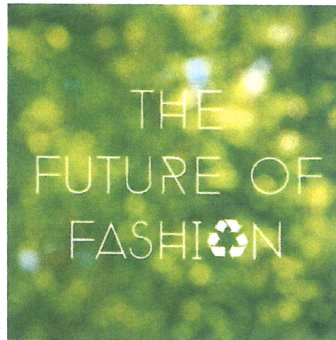

RULES for fair fashion and taking care of our environment:

2. Buy secondhand clothes and save money.
3. Buy used clothing and help our environment.
4. less clothing waste
5. Secondhand clothes last a long time.



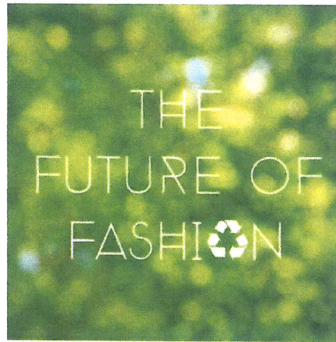
RULES for fair fashion and taking care of our environment:

1. Have a clearout - you know what you need and what you don't need!

2. Learn from your mistakes - look how many times you wear this!

3. Go Secondhand first - don't buy anything new!

4. Who made my clothes? - worry about who and how people make your clothes!



RULES for **fair fashion** and taking care of our environment:

1. Buying secondhand clothes - save money and resources!
2. Ask who made my clothes.
3. Don't throw your clothes away, give them to other People.
4. Look what materials your clouthes are made of - chemicals escape into the enviroment.
5. Buy cClothes that you need.
