Instructions to the game / quiz

The game / quiz is for 2 – 6 pupils. They will need:

- the map of the Slovak Republic with QR Codes
- the particular cards with questions
- the Smartphones or tablets with QR code reader

At the beginning, pupils decide who will start the game, then they'll take turns clockwise.

The cards lie on the desk, the questions are on the "bottom" site of the cards.

The first pupil picks up one card, reads the question and looks for the answer.

He / she looks for the place mentioned on the card in the map, uses his / her Smartphone or tablet to read the QR code.

As soon as he / she finds the answer on the Internet he / she will tell the answer to the others.

For each correct answer, he / she'll get a point.

The winner is the pupil who'll get the most points.




