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Souvenirs activities H4D+RBTTI

On 15th March, students of English in the 1st year of secondary education participated in an activity which related our Erasmus+ project "Heritage for development" and the other big project in our school "Proyecto Promoción Turística Sostenible de la Reserva de la Biosfera TajoTejo Internacional (RBTTI)" (Project on Sustainable Touristic Promotion of the TajoTejo International Biosphere Reserve).



For this activity, students had to look for information and make a short presentation about important monuments in Cracow by following the map designed by our coordinator in Poland.

After knowing some of the heritage that can be found in Cracow, our students carried out *Activity 4: Souvenirs market analyses*, included in the padlet *C1 Poland - Industrial Heritage*.

Once our students had been familiarized with different types of souvenirs, they were asked to design the drawings to be included in some badges which would be meant to be souvenirs from our local area. For their paintings, we asked them to get inspiration in our Biosphere Reserve, which they know quite well through Biology lessons, and it is part of our natural heritage.

This activity was carried out in collaboration with the Arts teacher, who explained students how to create concentric circles. Also, he taught one of his students how to use the machine to create the badges and students themselves created their own final products. Some of them were really good designs and will probably be used for promoting our natural heritage.
