Ship Breaker is a 2010 young adult novel
 by Paolo Bacigalupi set in a post-
 apocalyptic future. Human civilization is
 in decline for ecological reasons. The
 polar ice caps have melted and low
 oxygen is underwater. On the Gulf
 Coast nearby, humanity has reverted to
 survival mode and a small economy has
 grown from the scavenging of washed
 up oil tankers for bits of copper and
 other valuables.

Nailer is a 12-year-old boy who
 works on the night crew. His mother died
 when he was a young boy and he now
 lives with his alcoholic and drug addic-
 ted father, Richard Lopez. After a storm,
 Nailer rescues Nita, the stranded daugh-
 ter of a wealthy merchant, and helps her
 to get back home. Unintentionally, she
 uncovers several parties, including
 Nailer's father, the local power brokers,
 and Nita's father's enemies, including
 Nita's uncle Pyle.



Survival?

It's a fast, disciplined novel, mov-
 ing with tremendous coded ener-
 gy and urgency. I found it a tad
 colourless in places, but Nailer is
 a fine hero, complicated and
 questioning, always wondering
 whether he's doomed to inherit
 his father's failings or whether he
 can make his own destiny.

Which is, of course, the essential
 question of every dystopia. And
 basically the essential question of
 every teenager, too. Why do teen-
 agers like dystopias? Simple.
 They're looking for proof that
 there's a way to survive the one in
 which they're already living.
