RADISH	SLOVAKIA	from 15th March to 15th April	in rows, distance between rows 25 - 35 cm, in 1 - 1,5 cm depth, after germination when cotyledons are visible we must prick the plants out for 3 - 4 cm distance between plants	it needs more light and more water, water it at least once a day	3 - 6 weeks after sowing
LETUCCE	SPAIN	from August to March/April (in Spain we have the whole year)	Sowed as close as possible (1cm depth), because they protect each other. They can be sowed in two different ways: directly in the bed, or in seedbeds and then transplant them. 2nd way: when transplanted, there should be around 20cm among each lettuce.	It needs quite a lot of water because of their leaves. They can be protected from snails with ash. They need fresh and humid environment.	3-4 weeks after sowing. Two ways: pulling directly from the root or cutting just before the root so we can get a new lettuce.
PARSLEY	GERMANY	from 15th March to 15th April	min. ground temperature 8 °C, in rows from 15 bto 20 cm, 1,5 cm depth (seed needs darkness and up to 4 weeks to germinate), after germination: prick germs when they reach 5 cm of altitude for 5 - 7 cm distance (3 fingers wide)	keep ground humide all the time	8 -12 weeks later, depending on sun and temperature
TOMATOES	ITALY	from 25th March to the end of May	Tomatoes are long-season, heat-loving plants that won't tolerate frost, so it's best to set them into the garden as transplants (young plants). After the weather has warmed up in spring. In March you can plant tomatoes seed in small pots, put them inside a green house As soon as the plants grow, plant them into raised bed. it' is important not less than 30cm otherwise the painls can't grow well. Moisten the top layer and leave them in a greenhouse or cover the pots to keep them warm providing good air circulation. As soon as you see sprouts remove the covering. Water well the plants avoiding it in the afternoon.
