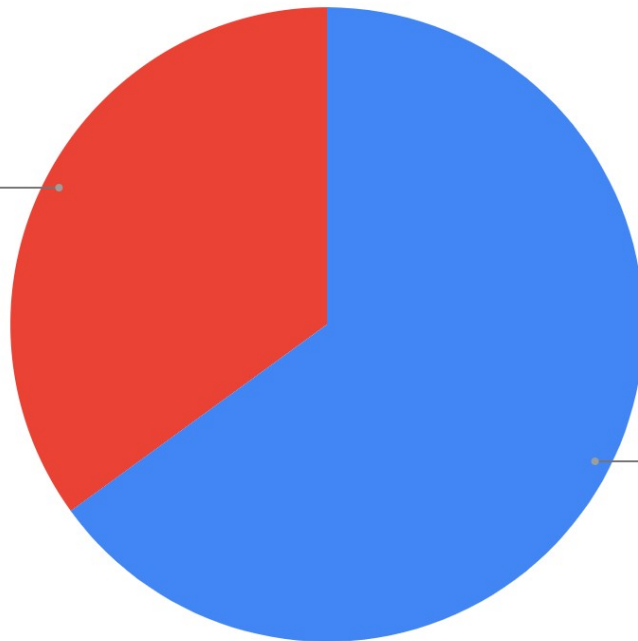


Schooling System
