"Eventually, Liesel Meminger walked gingerly inside. Hans Hubermann had her by one hand."



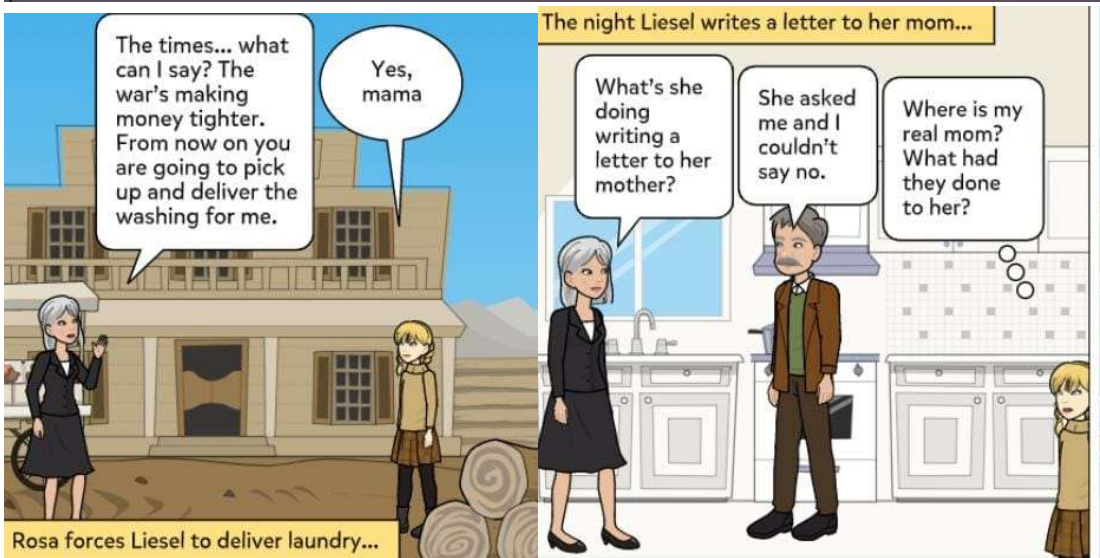
"(...) it was not so much the school who helped me to read. It was papa."

Hans organises a plan to convince the others that he is a true Nazi German because in real life he is a Jew lover



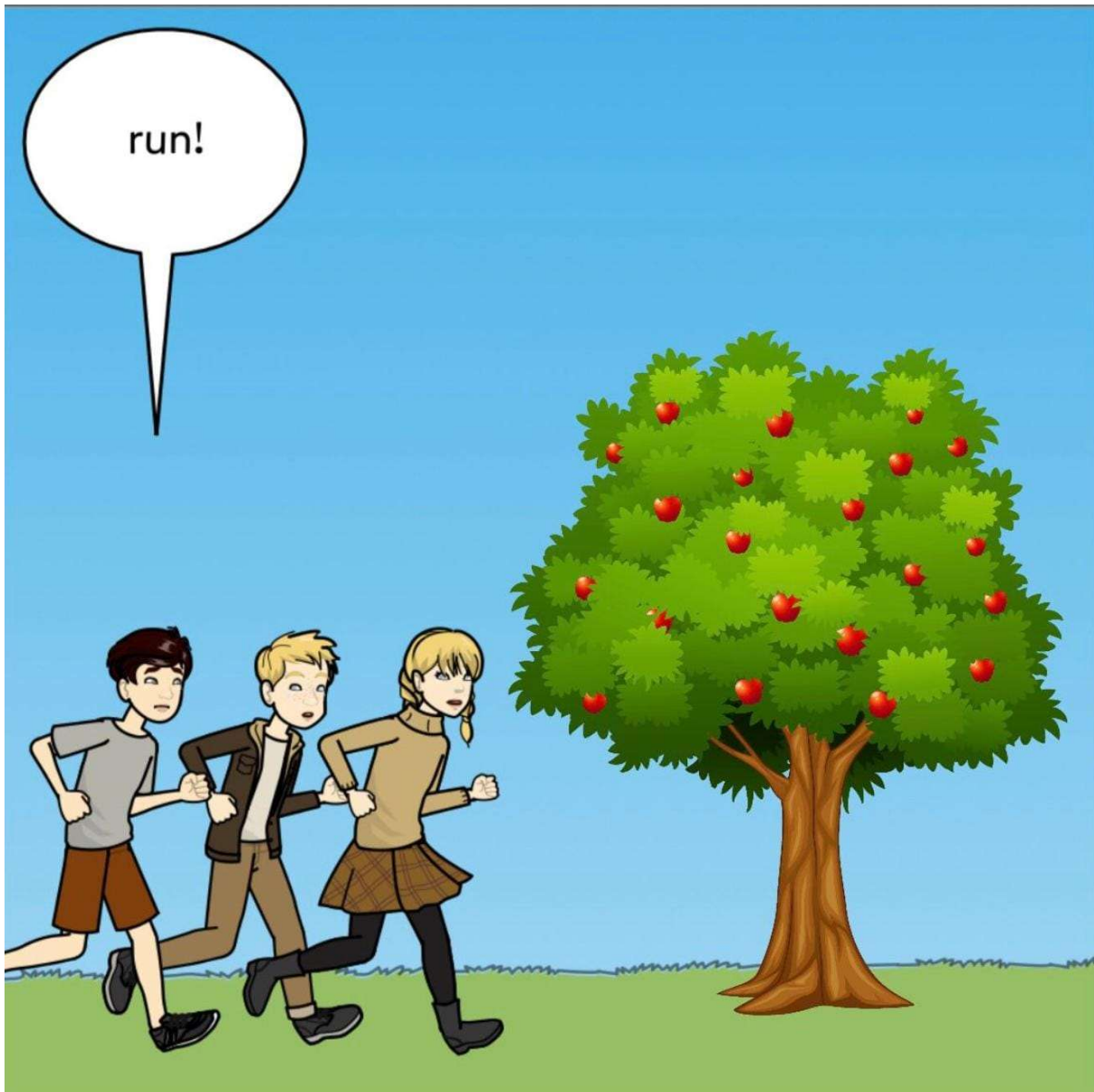

Liesel wants to tell Max something about life outside

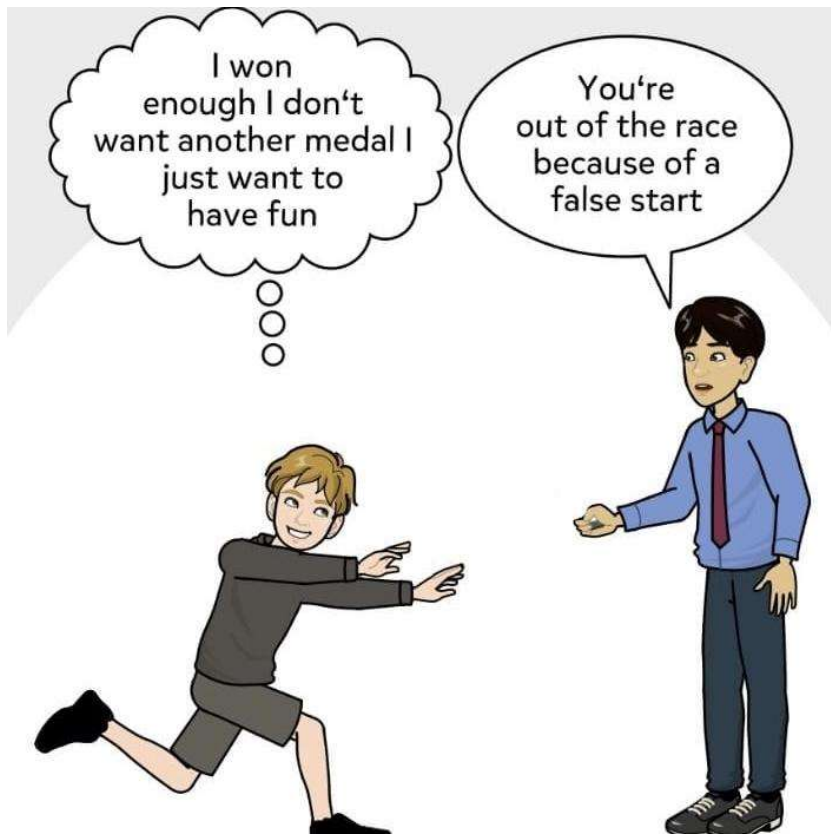




The policemen are looking for hidden Jews but they don't find Max

Everyone is in the air raid shelter

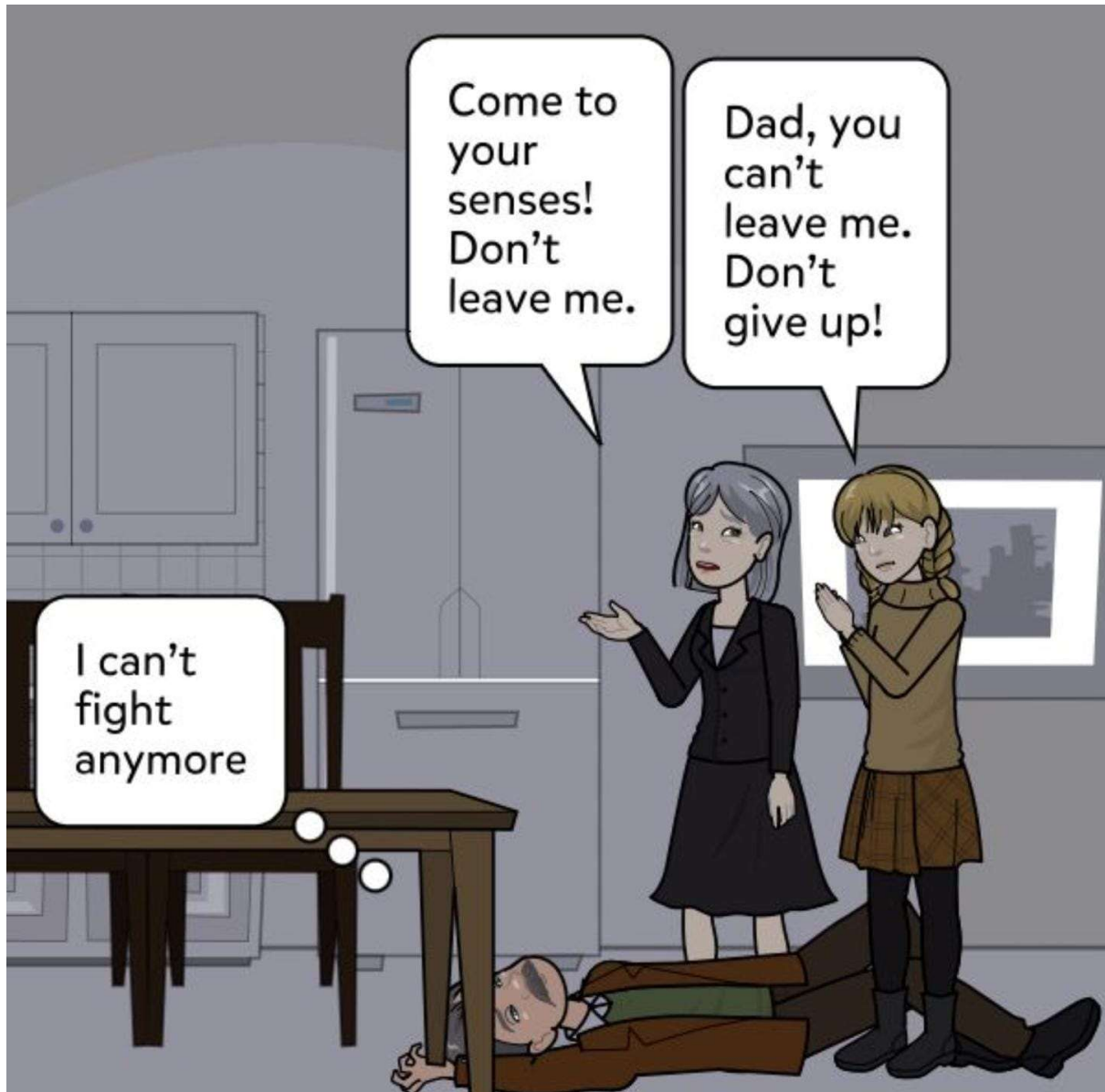

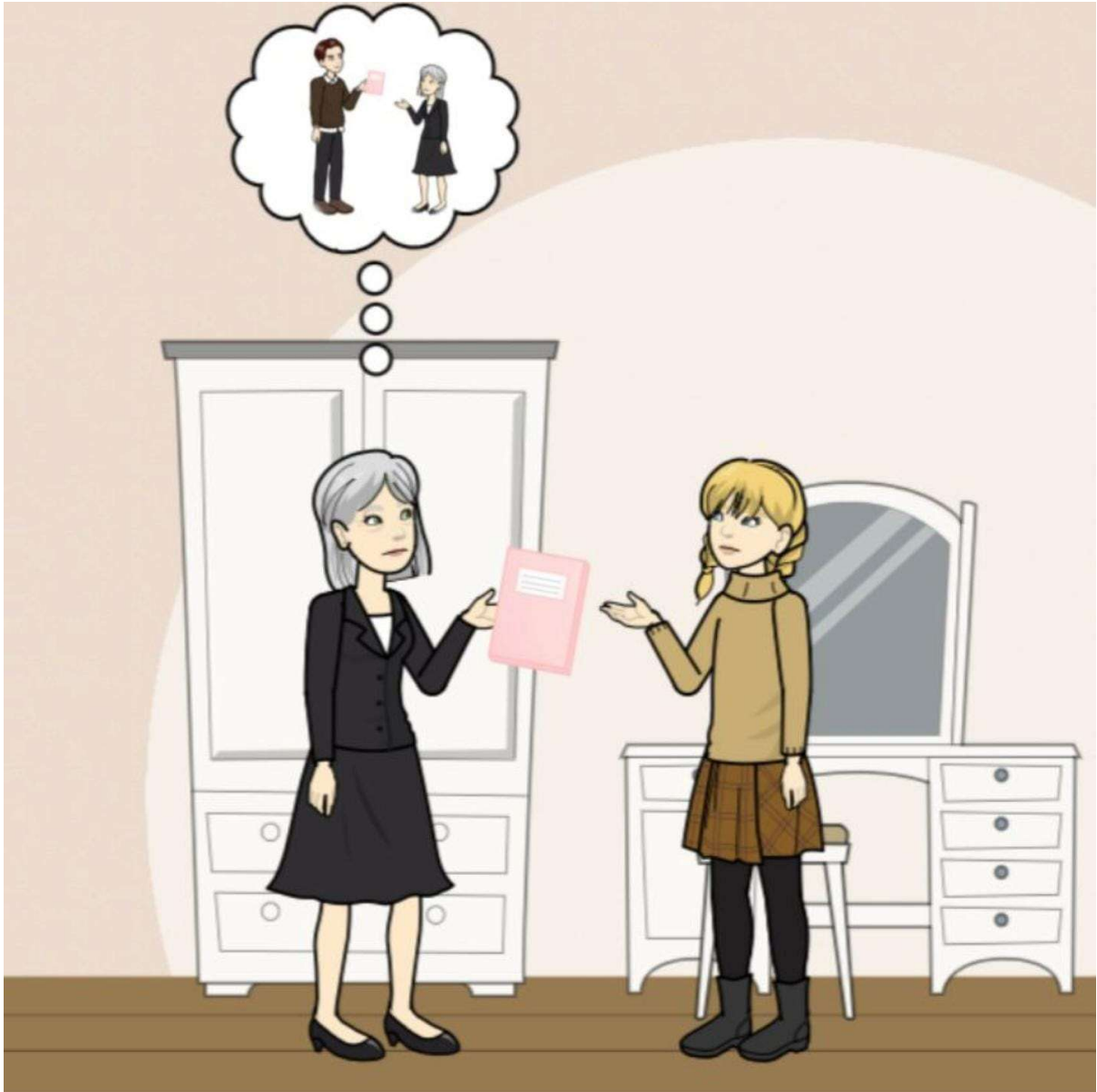




Hans has to go to war and fight

A pilot is dying and Liesel gives him her teddy bear

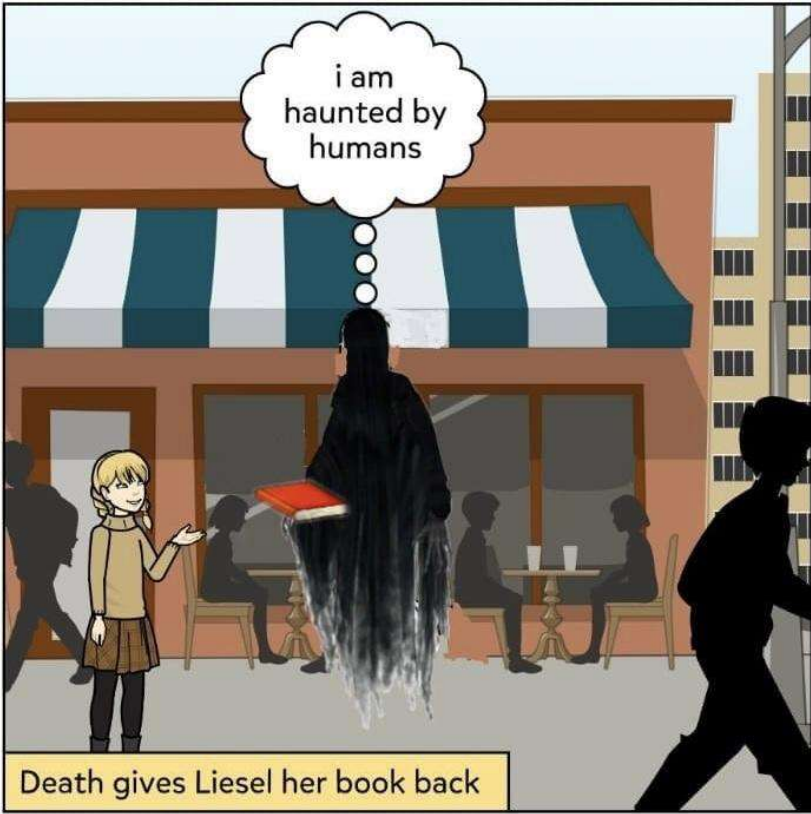


Max?!
