
## HEROIC MOMENTS IN THE BOOK THIEF

Liesel had problems reading in class and the teacher slapped her






Hans organises a plan to convince the others that he is a true Nazi German because in real life he is a Jew lover

To show Liesel how thankful he is, he makes her a gift








Liesel wants to tell Max something about life outside
