DESCRIPTION

• It is the act of setting fire to cardboard or wood monuments (called <u>"FALLA"</u>) during the festivities of several towns in the Valencian Community (Spain).Las <u>"FALLAS"</u> de Valencia, take place every year between March 15th and March 19th.

Las "FALLAS" usually consist of a central figure or composition several meters high, the largest exceeding 30 meters. Both in the **FALLA** fire is usually set to the monument by means of a firecracker, and in recent times it is also common to be accompanied by fireworks. Next the monument is lit to the rhythm of popular songs. Generally, so that all the burnings of all the monuments do not coincide at the same time, they are usually burned at different times, according to the prizes awarded to the monuments.
