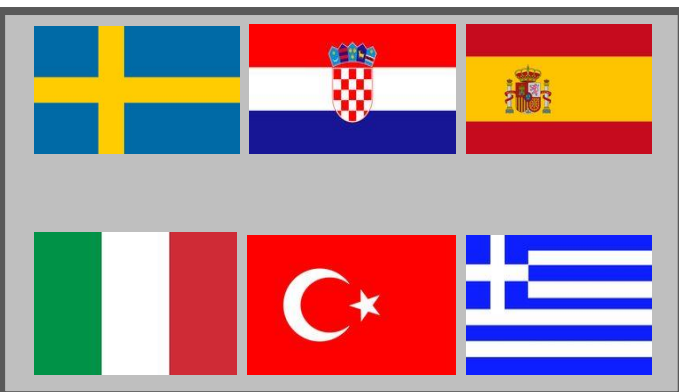

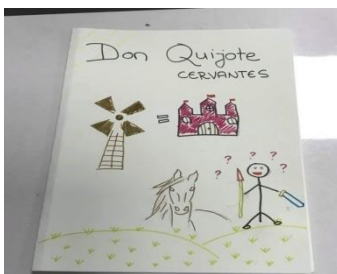
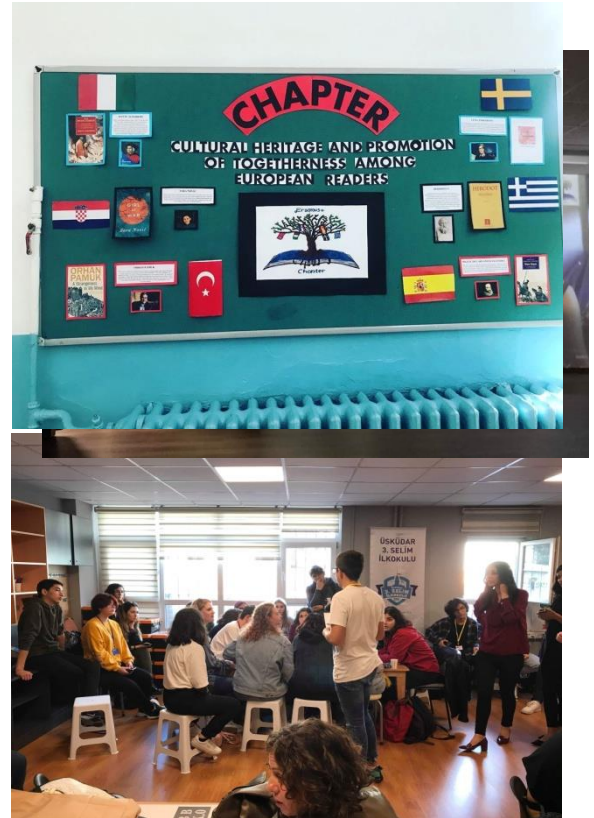


Newsletter#1

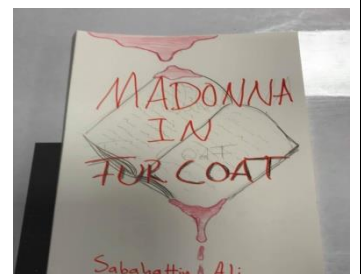
BOOK COVER DESIGNED BY CROATIA TEAM



BOOK COVER DESIGNED BY TURKEY TEAM



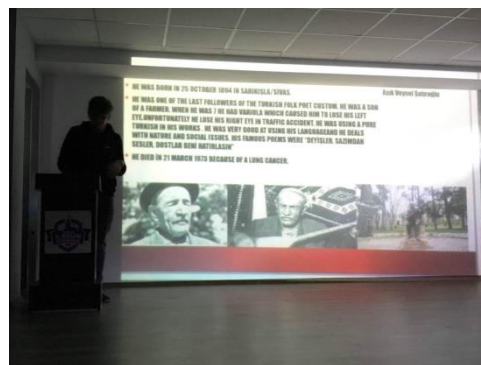
BOOK COVER DESIGNED BY SPAIN TEAM
