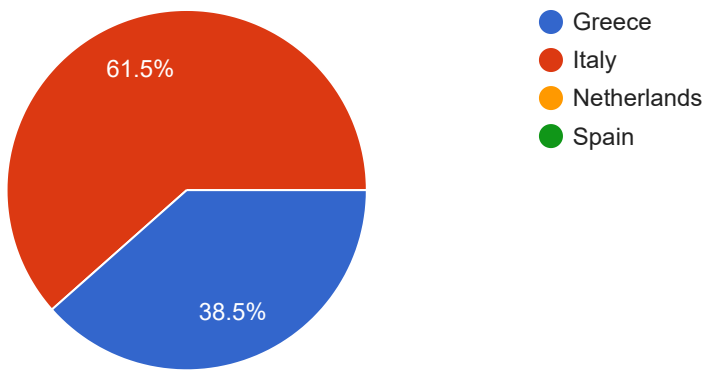

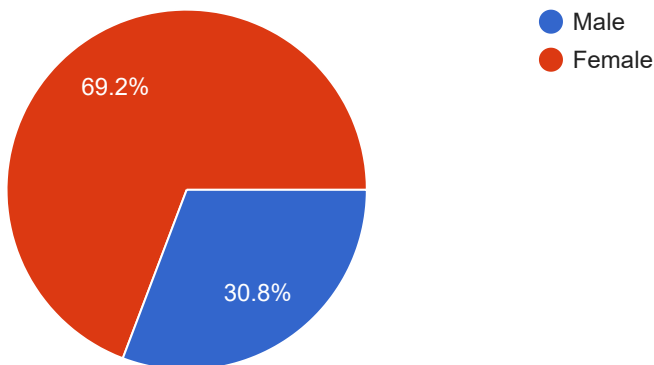
Where are you from?

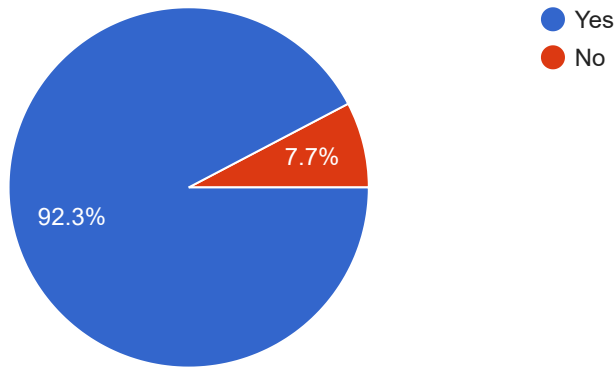

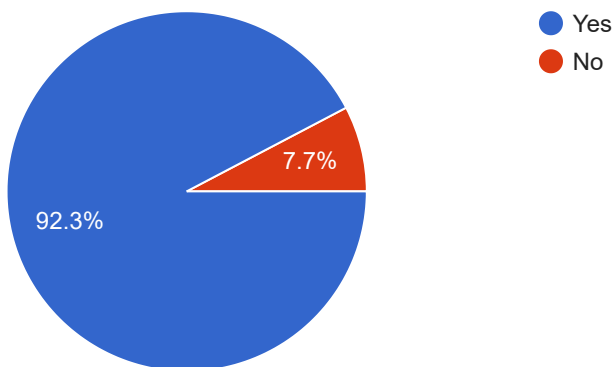

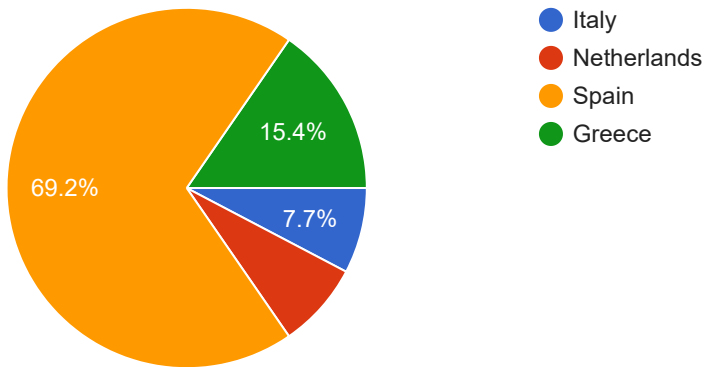
11. If yes, with how many?
