Ideas for the meeting with students in Sevilla, Spain

MEETING IN HOOGEVEEN – January 24 – 26 - 2018

In advance

- ask for subjects, wishes from partners;
- sent all the information about accomodation, the travel from airport to Hoogeveen, the costs for diner and trips, the program.

During the meeting

- **Choose new dates for the last visit with students to Greece;**
- Evaluation of the previous period (nov. - jan);
- Talk about products and goals;
- Prepare the visit for the students in Spain;
- Planning the tasks for the students;
- The teachers get the possibility to see the daily school life and get in contact with other Dutch teachers (for example: Patrizia will meet the English teacher who's in charge of Cambrigde);
- We ask a teacher from another school to tell us about the creating of a website;
- We can arrange a training for the teachers/students.

Meeting for students in Spain

- First day: travel day, meeting at school, welcome, student goes to hostfamily;
- The host school organizes activities to get to know each other;
- One of the days is dedicated to digital learning, working etc. The students follow a few lessons.
- The host school takes care of the daily program; the host families take care of the activities in the evening.
