Il territorio umbro è caratterizzato da una morfologia prevalentemente collinare, con altitudini che variano tra i 200 e i 1500 metri s.l.m. Le zone collinari sono ricche di boschi e pascoli, mentre le vallate sono fertili e adatte all'agricoltura. Il clima è temperato, con inverni miti e estati calde e secche.

La capitale della regione è Perugia, situata su una collina a 200 metri di altezza dal livello del mare. Altre città importanti sono Assisi, Foligno, Terni e Spello. La regione è attraversata da diverse autostrade e strade statali, che facilitano i collegamenti con le altre regioni italiane.

La cucina umbra è molto gustosa e tipica, con piatti come la cinghialella, il vitello tonnato e il sugo di pecora. La regione è anche famosa per i suoi vini, in particolare il Sangiovese e il Rosso di Assisi. Il turismo è molto sviluppato, con molte città d'arte e siti storici da visitare.

- **9th April, Tuesday**

On the first day, in the morning, the project and the relevant activities are presented.

Foreign students accompanied by Italian peers will be taken into some classrooms in order to participate to some lessons from about 10.00 to 10.45.

In the afternoon there is the visit to Orte historical centre.
The students are divided into two groups.

GROUP A - 1, 2,3,4 and Italian – Greek teachers

GROUP B – 5,6,7,8 and Dutch – Spanish teachers

- **10th April, Wednesday**

Students work at school in the morning hours.

By using a mapline, they localize the sites they are going to visit.

Then they choose the mode (video, presentation, brochure etc..) by which they want to realize their work.

After that, they start planning the tourist packet.

In the afternoon students go trekking and visit Pierpaolo Pasolini Tower and the Etruscan Pyramid.

- **11th April, Thursday**

Visit to Florence

- **12th April, Friday**

In the morning students go on with their work; they have to focus on the sporting activities that can be practiced, the accommodation facilities and the restaurants or other places to try local food. After the break, they have to work on the proposal of alternative new sports activities that could be practiced in a certain area.

In the afternoon there is the trekking activities at Marmore Falls.

- **13th April, Saturday**

Visit to the Park of Monsters in Bomarzo.

After a light lunch, from about 1,30 pm, students conclude their works.

At about 4,30 pm they return to the hosting families.

At about 7 pm: farewell party and the presentation of the product to the families and to all the audience.
