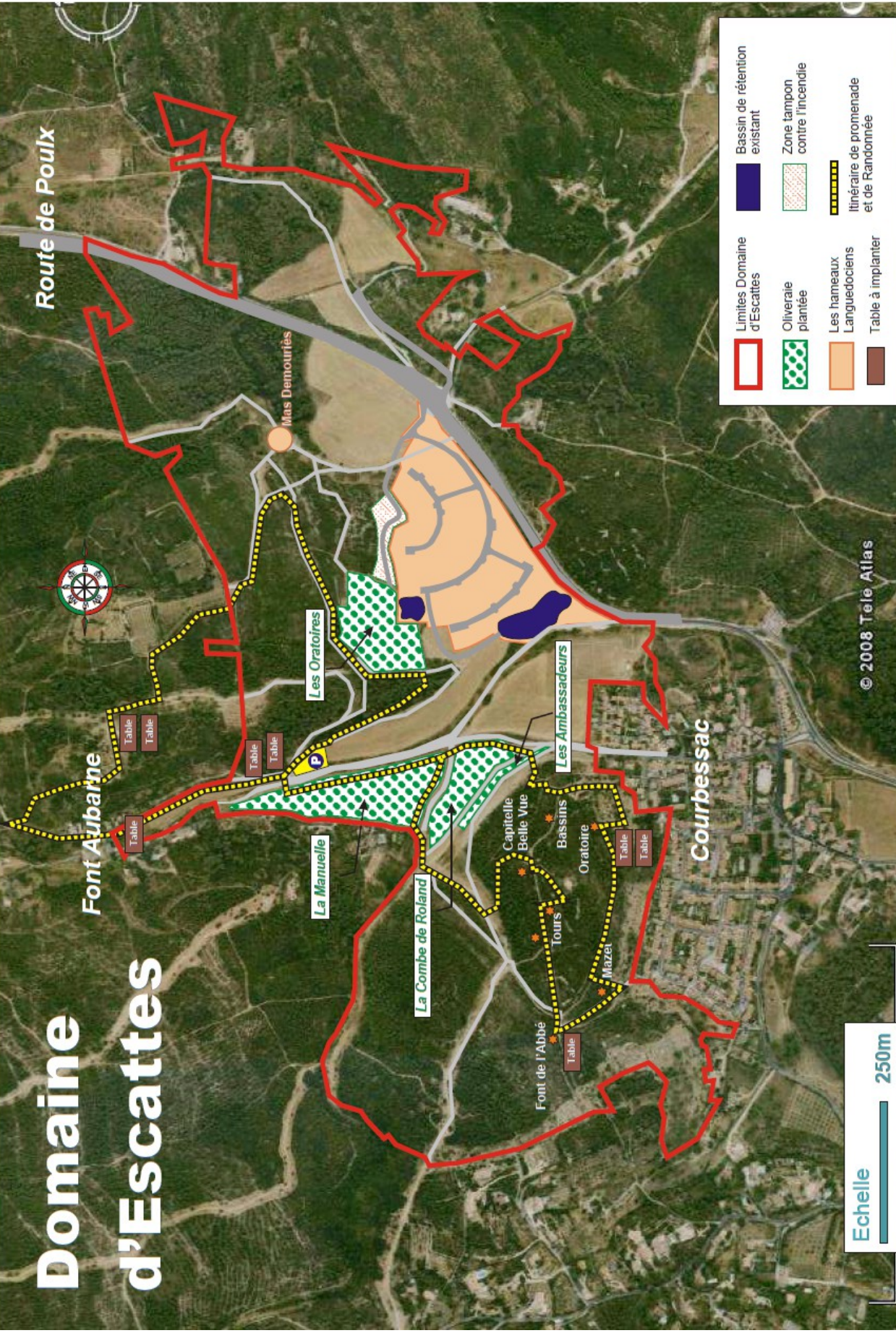

Detailed way to borrow

Landmarks :

We'll follow the Yellow-way.

Group 1 :

*From the car park,go west(way on the left of the car park)

*Continue straight ahead,you should see a stone wall stacked on the right landscape.

*You'll arrive at the edge of a village , there is a house with small stairs leading to a red door.

*The path to take is behind,you'll pass by a bus stop on the right.

*Once you get to the top,you will see the sign of « Mas d'ecattes » (as well as others indicating that hunting is practiced there etc..) from there you will almost turn backward,but this time we take the beginning of the yellow marking.

(Notes : if you are on the right path you should see a piece of forest that has been burned ,in your landscape.)

*Follow the marking and your map. You're in height,you will pass through a small stone bridge at your feet.

*It is in this part that you must see a lot of construction around you,and even stone tables.

*So,you are near the meeting point,on the plain from above.

Group 2 :

*From the car park, go east, behind ,at right.You will enter the heart of the forest,remember to check the yellow marking,cause you're tking the opposite way to the group 1.

*Continue until you reach a place where you can see in the distance houses,roads,etc. Besides, near you there are an olive-tree grove from wich you are separated by fences.

*Follow this landscape by staying on the right, alonging it.

Stritly follow the marking,wich will take you up inside the forest.

*At the edge of the small path you should see several types of plants quite varied.There will be also,some stone structures in your environemment.

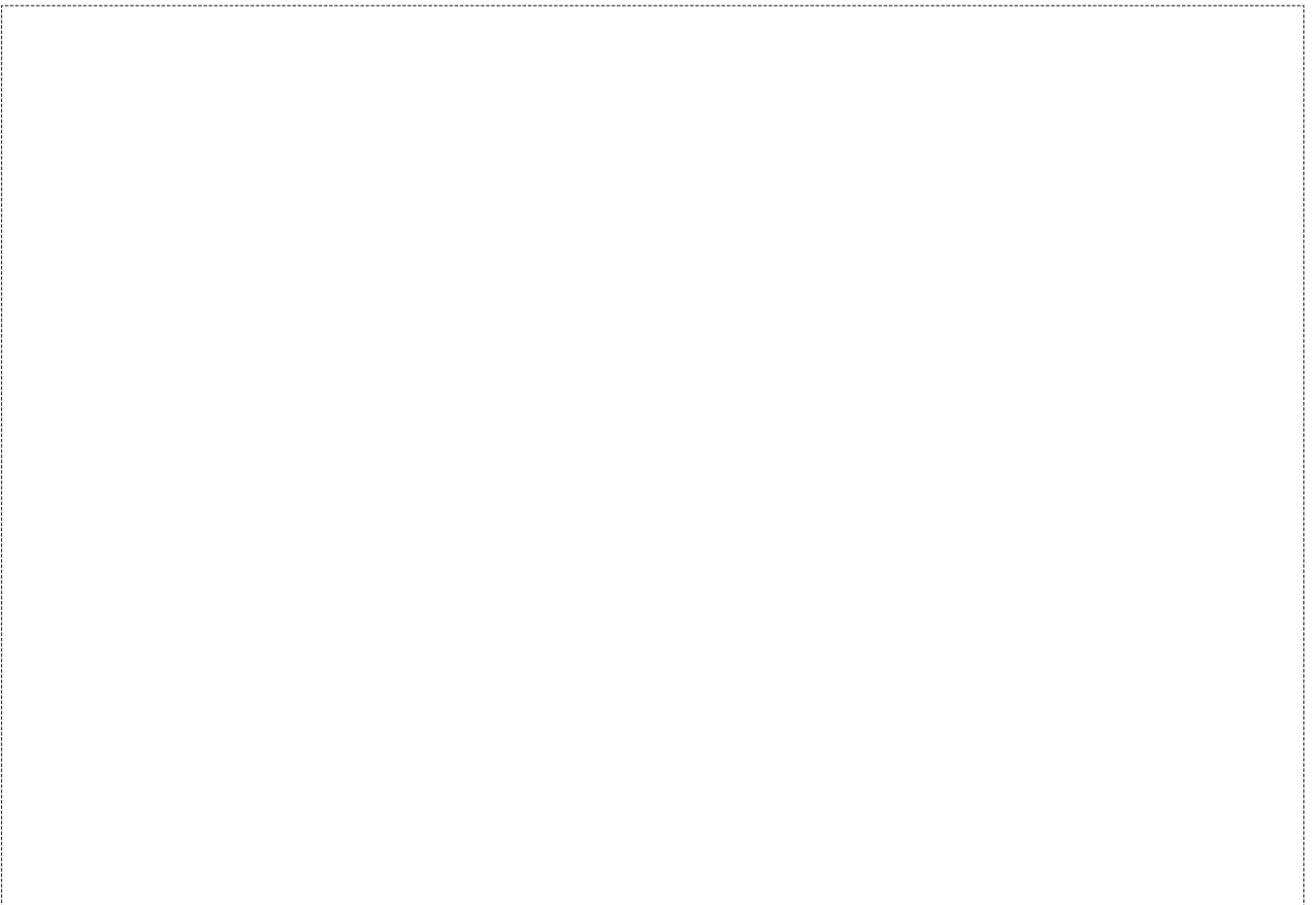
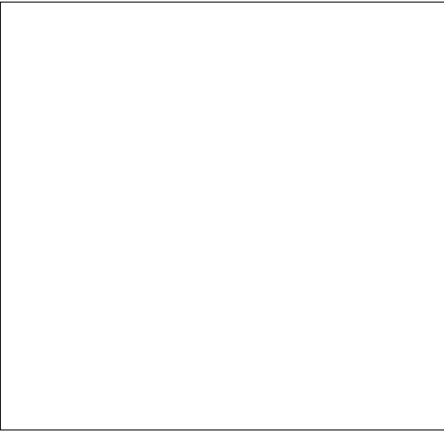
*Finally at the top you will reach a viewpoint,to observe the surroundings. Continue at the opposite direction of it. Head towards the plain that's where the meeting point is.

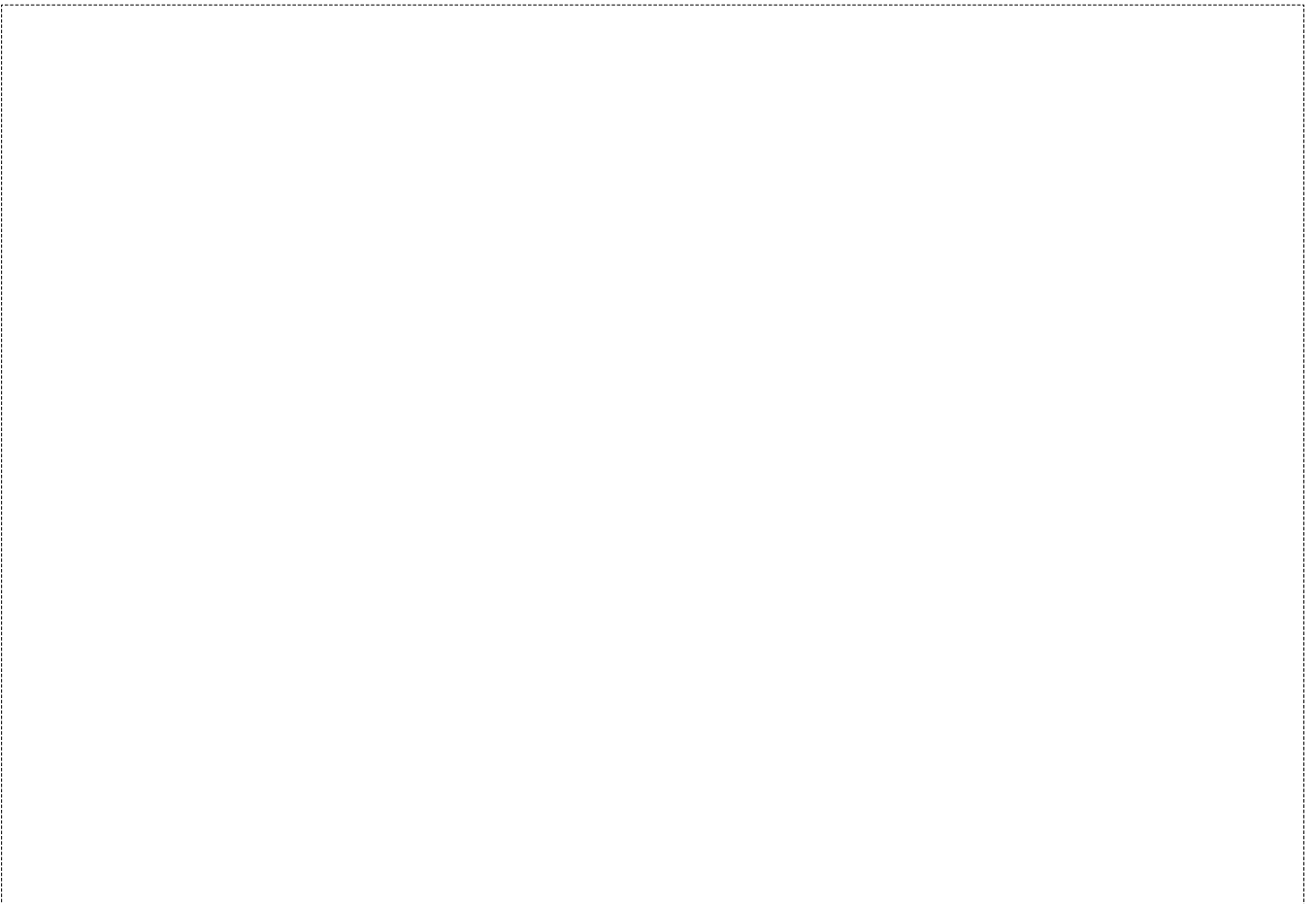
If you are in group 1 same instruction. For an exemple the olive tree grove is on of the last thing you will see. Be Careful with the yellow-marks


3. Aromatic plant with stem
