# Berries in Sweden

Here you have some facts about different berries you can find in Sweden.



### Cloudberry

It's a berry that looks like a raspberry but it's yellow instead of red. They are growing on mires and have small, hard seeds and the taste is sweet.



# Wild strawberry

Looks like a very small strawberry. It is a bit rare but grows on the side of the road, forest and meadows. The taste is very sweet.



### Lingonberry

A red berry that's very sour, mature between August and September. We use it to make lingonberry jam.

We eat it to palt, porridge, meatballs, etc.



# Blueberry

One of the healthiest berries for humans and animals, we use it for a lot of things like pie, jam and blueberry soup.



### Raspberry

Mature in June and grows wild throughout Sweden. Often used to juice and jam.



#### **Bramble**

Grows mainly in north Norrland coast land. Maybe one of the tastiest berries in Europe. Norrbottens flower landscape.
