NATURE PARK PAPUK

Papuk is the first and only geopark in Croatia. The rocks are over 400 million years old. Huge sea waves broke and bounced off a Papuk. Above the waves foamed by the force of the blows on Papuk's ground giant sharks, whales and dolphins appeared.



The first Croatian geological monument of nature, Rupnica, is located on Papuk.

Rupnica is a phenomenon formed from volcanoes. A natural mosaic of rocks arranged like huge stone pillars, arranged like stairs.



The characteristics of Papuk are forests, mostly beech, which are the habitat of deer, roe deer, foxes, wild boars



There are few wet lawns compared to dry ones.



The waters of Papuk are dynamic, clear and cold. Mountain streams are home to specific fish species, amphibians and reptiles.
