

We decided to do a survey about what students think about immigration and the difficult situation of refugees.

We administered this survey to 431 people from The Netherlands, Italy, Turkey, Greece, Denmark. Our statistical sample is composed of 38% by Netherlands students, 52% of Italian, 5% of Turkish, 4% of Danish and 1% Greek.

At first we asked the difference between refugees and immigrants from a legal perspective. As we can see from the pie chart half of the students answered that they know the difference. Instead the remaining affirmed that they didn't know the differences very well.

Then talking about numbers.. we have found out that only the 26% is aware about the migrants and asylum seekers'situation. That shows us how it is important to discuss about this topic in schools.

Another important result is that : more than the half has never taken part in a social activity project with immigrants or refugees. This is another evidence of disinformation and the low level of young people's involvement in integration projects.

Nevertheless we received a positive confirmation! Young people know that the reason why this people leave their country is vital or very important.

The survey is going to finish. We ask to you to pay attention to this part because is the core of the survey.

When we asked to express emotion about this theme the 54% declared to feel comprehension, compassion. Also the data are for more than half positive, the 40% declared that is supportive to a limited number of situations.

Then we asked to students to decide a solution for this problem the main answer are : help and receive them and stay informed.

In this last pie chart, we can see that the 37% is favourable to use all the resources that the government has to welcome and integrate them in society. On the other side the 28% think that the national government should activate policy to limit the migration flow. Besides that 30% prefer to send humanitarian aid to their countries. Fortunately only 4% declare that they want to expell them finally.

We think that the answer we have received instill hope and faith. The global result of this survey give hope and trust to young generation and to the future. Even if there is lots of work to do to get better the situation.
