Subject/ Course:	Culture and Drama
Topic:	A role play on the immigrants' journey
Lesson Title:	Looking for a better future: a journey from Syria
Level:	Medium
Duration:	10 hours
Lesson Objectives:	
 The aim of this Teaching Unit is to make the students enact a performance about the Journey of Immigrants across the Mediterranean Sea. Objectives Promoting Cooperation Improving mimic skills and body control Improving critical sensibility Improving searching and analysis skills Entertaining and expressing your ideas to the audience Re-enacting a short performance Recording a Video 	
Summary of tasks/ actions:	
 Phase 1 – Warming up Gather the students, discuss the topic of immigration, divide in groups. Phase 2 - Brainstorming each group has to find information on the Web and write a short essay about the immigrants' journey, invent a short story, turn the short story into a script. Phase 3 - Rehearsing enact a performance about the journey of an immigrant from Syria. Remember: you can use music, images, videos, quotes and data, you can involve the audience, be creative, each member of the group must have a role. 	

- Remember: Everyone is important!
- Phase 4 Acting
- Perform in front of an audience,
- Film the performance,
- Involve the audience, elicit feedback.
