Ecology board games rules

Procedure:

- . The game is played in teams of approximately four (it can also be played in teams with more students). Each team has their own paper version of the game and the list of possible answers to check in case of doubts (or just the teacher has it). Each player must have a token to mark where (s)he stands on the board.
- . The first player rolls the die. The student moves his / her token according to the number on the die. (S)he then answers the question. Normally, the person plays till (s)he fails but in class, to make sure everybody plays, I suggest giving points for each good answer to the players who play in turn. If the game is not finished at the end of the lesson, the student with more points wins. If a player doesn't know an answer, the others don't give it and wait for another player to fall on that square. The normal game is that the person who reaches the last square wins.
- . The teacher acts as a judge if needed.
